RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, INTO THE SHOOTING OF TWO MASUNGI GEORESERVE FOREST RANGERS IN BARAS, RIZAL

WHEREAS, according to news reports, on July 24, 2021, two forest rangers of the Masungi Georeserve were shot in the head and neck by unidentified assailants while guarding the reforestation site in Baras, Rizal;

WHEREAS, the Masungi Georeserve is cared for, protected, and loved by a group of passionate individuals for the environment and the place. Initiatives are led and funded by Blue Star Construction & Development Corporation and the foundation body of Masungi Georeserve. They do their conservation efforts, alongside the communities of Pinugay, Baras, Cuyambay, and Tandang Kutyo1;

WHEREAS, it was reported that the shooting happened at a ranger station near GSB resort in Sitio San Roque in Brgy. Pinugay. The resort is one of the infrastructures said to be illegally occupying forestland in the Upper Marikina River Basin Protected Landscape²;

WHEREAS, it was reported that the incident happened more than a week after the Department of the Interior and Local Government recommended the filing of criminal and administrative charges against several local officials and establishments over encroachment in the Upper Marikina Watershed3;

WHEREAS, according to news reports, Masungi Georeserve Foundation had previously butted heads with quarrying companies and private firms that claimed

ownership over parts of the watershed, sounding the alarm on environmental violations, such as i legal logging⁴;

WHEREAS, it was reported that the Philippines has earned the dubious title of being the deadliest place for earth warriors in Asia, and the second deadliest in the world next to Colombia. In a report, the watchdog Global Witness (GW) stated that 43 defenders were killed in the country in 2019, mostly in the resource-rich islands of Mindanao and Negros. Since 2016, scores of indigenous leaders, farmers, and state workers charged with protecting the environment have been the victims of incidents allegedly involving armed forces or paramilitary groups⁵;

WHEREAS, the country has a current ratio of one park ranger for every 4,000 hectares of land nationwide⁶;

WHEREAS, it is imperative for the government to put a stop to the unceasing harassment against and killings of forest rangers and environmental defenders;

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Senate to inquire into this matter, review and re-examine existing laws and policies regarding crimes against environmental forest rangers and environmental defenders considering the recent violent attacks against them:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Senate, to direct the appropriate Senate committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the shooting of two Masungi Georeserve forest rangers in Baras, Rizal.
