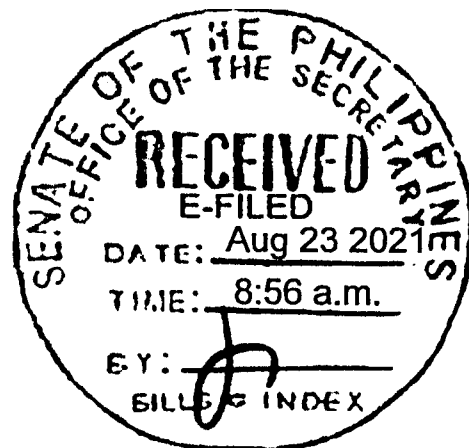

RESOLUTION
HONORING AND COMMENDING
