AN ACT

[CONVERTING] CHANGING THE NAME OF PINAGLABANAN HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY PINAGLABANAN, MUNICIPALITY OF GOA, PROVINCE OF CAMARINES SUR [INTO A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL] TO [BE KNOWN AS] PINAGLABANAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL[, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR]

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. [~~The Pinaglabanan High School in Barangay Pinaglabanan, Municipality~~
2 ~~of Goa, Province of Camarines Sur is hereby converted into a national high school to be known~~
3 ~~as Pinaglabanan National High School.~~] THE NAME OF PINAGLABANAN HIGH SCHOOL
4 IN BARANGAY PINAGLABANAN, MUNICIPALITY OF GOA, PROVINCE OF
5 CAMARINES SUR IS HEREBY CHANGED TO PINAGLABANAN NATIONAL HIGH
6 SCHOOL.

8 SEC. 2. [~~All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Pinaglabanan High School~~
9 ~~Sare hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Pinaglabanan National High School.~~] THE
10 MAIN CAMPUS OF THE PINAGLABANAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL SHALL
11 CONTINUE TO REMAIN IN ITS PRESENT LOCATION IN BARANGAY
12 PINAGLABANAN, MUNICIPALITY OF GOA, PROVINCE OF CAMARINES SUR.

14 [~~SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's~~
15 ~~program the operationalization of the Pinaglabanan National High School, the initial funding~~
16 ~~of which shall be charged against the current year's appropriation of the Pinaglabanan High~~
17 ~~School. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of the school shall be~~
18 ~~included in the annual General Appropriations Act.~~]

20 [~~SEC. 4. Within sixty (60) days after the approval of this Act, the Secretary of Education~~
21 ~~shall promulgate the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.~~]

23 SEC. [5] 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
24 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
