AN ACT

DECLARING OCTOBER 27 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF SARANGANI IN RECOGNITION OF ITS INDIGENOUS PEOPLES

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. October 27 of every year is hereby declared a special non-working holiday 2 in the Province of Sarangani in recognition of the immense contribution of its indigenous peoples 3 to society and the protection of the environment.

4 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official* 5 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
