AN ACT

SEPARATING THE LIBUDON NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL – SANGHAY EXTENSION IN BARANGAY SANGHAY, MATI CITY, PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL FROM THE LIBUDON NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS SANGHAY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. The Libudon National High School – Sanghay Extension in Barangay  
2 Sanghay, Mati City, Province of Davao Oriental is hereby separated from the Libudon  
3 National High School and converted into an independent national high school to be known as  
4 Sanghay National High School.  
5

6           SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Libudon National High  
7 School – Sanghay Extension are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Sanghay National  
8 High School.  
9

10          SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's  
11 program the operationalization of the Sanghay National High School, the initial funding of  
12 which shall be charged against the current year's appropriation of the Libudon National High  
13 School – Sanghay Extension. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation  
14 of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

16          SEC. 4. Within sixty (60) days after the approval of this Act, the Secretary of  
17 Education shall promulgate the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.  
18

19          SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*  
20 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
