AN ACT

ESTABLISHING A GENERAL HOSPITAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF VILLANUEVA, PROVINCE OF MISAMIS ORIENTAL TO BE KNOWN AS THE NORTHEASTERN MISAMIS GENERAL HOSPITAL (NMGH), AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** There shall be established a general hospital in the Municipality of
2 Villanueva, Province of Misamis Oriental, to be known as the Northeastern Misamis
3 General Hospital (NMGH), which shall be under the direct control and supervision of the
4 Department of Health (DOH).

5
6 Any future increase in bed capacity and upgrading of health care services and
7 facilities shall be based on the hospital development plan which shall be prepared by
8 the DOH.

10 **SEC. 2.** The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the Department's
11 program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the
12 annual General Appropriations Act.

14 **SEC. 3.** The Secretary of Health shall prepare and issue the necessary rules and
15 regulations for the effective implementation of this Act consistent with the hospital
16 development plan.

18 **SEC. 4.** If any provision or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the
19 remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

21 **SEC. 5.** All laws, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations, inconsistent
22 with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

1 **SEC. 6.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
2 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
