AN ACT
ESTABLISHING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALBAYOG, PROVINCE OF SAMAR, A
TERTIARY HOSPITAL TO BE KNOWN AS THE SAMAR ISLAND MEDICAL
CENTER, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 **SECTION 1.** There shall be established in the Municipality of Calbayog, Province
2 of Samar, a tertiary hospital to be known as the Samar Island Medical Center, which
3 shall be under the direct control and supervision of the Department of Health (DOH).
4

5 **SEC. 2.** Any increase in bed capacity and upgrading of health care services and
6 facilities shall be based on the hospital development plan which shall be prepared by
7 the DOH.

9 **SEC. 3.** The Secretary of the DOH shall immediately include in the Department's
10 program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the
11 annual General Appropriations Act.

13 **SEC. 4.** If any provision or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the
14 remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.
15

16 **SEC. 5.** All laws, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations, inconsistent
17 with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

19 **SEC. 6.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
20 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
