AN ACT DECLARING AUGUST 12 OF EVERY YEAR AS NATIONAL YOUTH DAY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. – This Act shall be known as the "National Youth Day
 Act."

3 **SEC. 2.** Declaration of Policy. – The State recognizes the vital role of the youth 4 in nation-building and which has led to measures such as Republic Act No. 8044 which created the National Youth Commission to be the leading government arm in 5 harnessing the full potential of the youth as partners in nation building and Republic 6 Act No. 10742 or the "Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015" which provided a 7 strong framework to encourage the youth not only to participate in governmental 8 activities and public and civic affairs but to also develop a sense of leadership at 9 patriotism. 10

SEC. 3. National Youth Day. – In observance of the International Youth Day,
 the twelfth (12th) day of August of every year is hereby declared as National Youth
 Day.

SEC. 4. *Program of Activities.* – To ensure the meaningful observance of National Youth Day, the National Youth Commission (NYC), in coordination with the Department of Education (DepEd), Commission on Higher Education (CHED), and

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Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), Sangguniang 1 Kabataan (SK) National Union of Students of the Philippines (NUSP), and other youth 2 and youth-serving organizations shall prepare and implement an annual program of 3 activities including, but not limited to, discussions and/or forums on career paths, 4 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), environment preservation, gender equality, 5 and mental health. For this purpose, the NYC may engage in partnerships with local 6 and international youth organizations suitable to providing these discussions. The 7 youth organizations and youth-serving organizations shall likewise support the NYC in 8 its effort to promote and facilitate related activities in all public and private schools. 9

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10 All schools, colleges, and universities are hereby enjoined to launch activities 11 such as leadership training, youth empowerment, workshops, basic mass integration, 12 and community immersion activities in celebration of National Youth Day: *Provided*, 13 That the specific activities to be undertaken shall be at the discretion of the school 14 administration: *Provided*, further, That, the respective administration of schools, 15 colleges, and universities shall extend their full support to all activities to be conducted 16 by their students.

17 All provincial and local youth development offices are likewise enjoined to 18 prepare an annual program and conduct activities that shall provide holistic 19 development and enrichment of the youth in their respective communities.

20 **SEC. 5.** *Implementing Rules and Regulations.* – The NYC, in coordination with 21 DepEd, CHED, and TESDA, SK, NUSP and other youth and youth-serving organizations 22 shall promulgate the rules and regulations to implement this Act within sixty (60) days 23 after its effectivity.

SEC. 6. *Appropriations.* – The amounts necessary for the implementation of this act shall be charged against the respective current year available appropriation of the NYC, DepEd, CHED and SK. Thereafter, the amounts necessary shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 7. *Separability Clause.* - If, for any reason or reasons, any part or parts of this act shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by any competent court, other sections or provisions hereof not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

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SEC. 8. *Repealing Clause.* – all laws, decrees, executive orders or rules and
 regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby
 repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 9. *Effectivity Clause.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation.
