AN ACT
INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE BAGUIO GENERAL HOSPITAL AND
MEDICAL CENTER IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO, PROVINCE OF BENGUET, FROM
EIGHT HUNDRED (800) TO ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (1500) BEDS, AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 **SECTION 1.** The authorized bed capacity of the Baguio General Hospital and
2 Medical Center in the City of Baguio, Province of Benguet, is hereby increased from
3 eight hundred (800) to one thousand five hundred (1500) beds. Any future increase in
4 bed capacity shall be consistent with the hospital development plan that shall be
5 prepared by the Chief of Hospital of the Baguio General Hospital and Medical Center
6 and submitted to the Department of Health (DOH).
7
- 8 **SEC. 2.** The existing professional health care services and facilities of the Baguio
9 General Hospital and Medical Center shall also be upgraded to conform with and be
10 commensurate to the increase in bed capacity as provided for in Section 1 hereof
11
- 12 **SEC. 3.** The existing workforce of the Baguio General Hospital and Medical
13 Center, which includes doctors, nurses, and support personnel, shall be increased
14 correspondingly.

1 **SEC. 4.** The Secretary of the DOH shall, after consultation with the Chief of
2 Hospital of the Baguio General Hospital and Medical Center, and in coordination with
3 the Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management and the Chairperson of the
4 Civil Service Commission, determine the additional new positions to be created.

5
6 **SEC. 5.** The Secretary of the DOH shall immediately include in the Department's
7 program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the
8 annual General Appropriations Act.

9
10 **SEC. 6.** All laws, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations, inconsistent
11 with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly

12
13 **SEC. 7.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
14 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
