Recommending the approval of House Bill No. 10242 with amendments, taking into consideration Senate Bill No. 2244.

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Health and Demography, and Finance, to which were referred **House Bill No. 10242**, introduced by Representative Chatto, entitled:

**"AN ACT
CONVERTING THE GOVERNOR CELESTINO GALLARES MEMORIAL
HOSPITAL IN THE CITY OF TAGBILARAN, PROVINCE OF BOHOL TO
THE GOVERNOR CELESTINO GALLARES MULTI-SPECIALTY
MEDICAL COMPLEX, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR"**

and taking into consideration **Senate Bill No. 2244**, introduced by Senator Angara, entitled:

**"AN ACT
CONVERTING THE GOVERNOR CELESTINO GALLARES MEMORIAL
HOSPITAL (GCGMH) TO GOVERNOR CELESTINO
GALLARES MULTI-SPECIALTY MEDICAL COMPLEX
(GCGMMC) IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL AMENDING
REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11324, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS
THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"**

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 10242, taking into consideration Senate Bill No. 2244, be approved with the following amendments:

1. On page 1, delete SEC. 2, lines 7-10, and replace these with the following:

**"SEC. 2. THE GCGMMC SHALL BE COMPRISED OF THE FOLLOWING:
(1) THE GOV. CELESTINO GALLARES MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER IN
TAGBILARAN CITY, AND (2) THE MULTI-SPECIALTY MEDICAL
CENTER IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CORTES, PROVINCE OF BOHOL.**

**THE TWO FACILITIES COMPRISING THE GCGMMC SHALL OPERATE
AS SEPARATE AND DISTINCT FACILITIES FROM EACH OTHER AND
SHALL BE HEADED BY THEIR RESPECTIVE MEDICAL CENTER CHIEFS."**

2. On the same page, delete the entire SEC. 4, lines 16-21 until page 2, lines 1-4.
3. Renumber the subsequent sections accordingly.
4. On page 2, delete the entire SEC 6, lines 11-14.
5. Renumber the subsequent sections accordingly.

AN ACT

**CONVERTING THE GOVERNOR CELESTINO GALLARES MEMORIAL HOSPITAL
IN THE CITY OF TAGBILARAN, PROVINCE OF BOHOL TO THE GOVERNOR
CELESTINO GALLARES MULTI-SPECIALTY MEDICAL COMPLEX, AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 **SECTION 1.** The Governor Celestino Gallares Memorial Hospital in the City of
2 Tagbilaran, Province of Bohol, is hereby converted into a medical complex to be known
3 as the Governor Celestino Gallares Multi-Specialty Medical Complex (GCGMMC),
4 which shall be under the direct control and supervision of the Department of Health
5 (DOH).
6

7 **SEC. 2.** The GCGMMC shall be comprised of the Ambulatory Care Center in
8 Tagbilaran City and the Multi-Specialty Medical Center in the Municipality of Cortes,
9 Province of Bohol. It may establish branches in accordance with DOH programs and
10 rules and in such locations as the GCGMMC may thereafter identify.
11

12 **SEC. 3.** Any future increase in bed capacity, healthcare facilities, service
13 capability, and human resource complement shall be based on the hospital
14 development plan which shall be prepared by the DOH.
15

16 **SEC. 4.** The GCGMMC shall be headed by a Medical Center Chief, while the
17 Ambulatory Care Center and the Multi-Specialty Medical Center shall each be
18 supervised by a Deputy Medical Center Chief.
19

20 The salary grade of the positions of Medical Center Chief and Deputy Medical
21 Center Chief shall be at levels 27 and 25, respectively.

1 The Medical Center Chief and the Deputy Medical Center Chiefs shall be
2 licensed physicians who have earned a master's degree in Hospital Administration or an
3 equivalent post-graduate degree in management, in accordance with civil service rules
4 and regulations for positions of the same level.
5

6 **SEC. 5.** The DOH shall determine the staffing pattern of the GCGMMC subject
7 to the evaluation and approval of the Department of Budget and Management, and
8 appoint the officials and employees of the GCGMMC in accordance with existing civil
9 service laws, rules and regulations.
10

11 **SEC. 6.** The GCGMMC shall be exempted from the licensing requirement under
12 Republic Act No. 4226, entitled: "An Act Requiring the Licensure of All Hospitals in the
13 Philippines and Authorizing the Bureau of Medical Services to Serve as the Licensing
14 Agency."
15

16 **SEC. 7.** The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the Department's
17 program the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the
18 annual General Appropriations Act.
19

20 **SEC. 8.** If any part or provision of this Act is held invalid or unconstitutional, the
21 remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in force and effect.
22

23 **SEC. 9.** Republic Act No. 11324, entitled: "An Act Increasing the Bed Capacity of
24 Governor Celestino Gallares Memorial Hospital (GCGMH) in Tagbilaran City, Province
25 of Bohol from Two Hundred Twenty-Five (225) to Five Hundred Twenty-Five (525)
26 Beds, and Upgrading its Services and Facilities, Amending for the Purpose Republic Act
27 No. 7266, and Appropriating Funds Therefor and for Other Purposes," is hereby
28 amended accordingly.

30 All other laws, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations, inconsistent
31 with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
32

33 **SEC. 10.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
34 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
