AN ACT

ESTABLISHING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DON MARCELINO, PROVINCE OF DAVAO OCCIDENTAL, A COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, TO BE KNOWN AS THE LAMIDAN COMMUNITY HOSPITAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** There shall be established in the Municipality of Don Marcelino, Province of
2 Davao Occidental, a community hospital to be known as the Lamidan Community Hospital,
3 which shall be under the direct control and supervision of the Provincial Government of Davao
4 Occidental.

6 **SEC. 2.** The Provincial Government of Davao Occidental shall manage the Lamidan
7 Community Hospital, and prepare, in consultation with the Department of Health (DOH), a
8 hospital development plan that is aligned with the Philippine Health Facility Development Plan.
9 Any future increase in bed capacity, healthcare facilities, service capability, and human resource
10 complement shall be based on the hospital development plan.

12 **SEC. 3.** The Provincial Government of Davao Occidental shall provide the necessary
13 funds for the establishment of the Lamidan Community Hospital. The Secretary of the DOH
14 shall include in the Department's subsidy program, support for the capital outlay requirements of
15 the Lamidan Community Hospital.

17 **SEC. 4.** If any provision or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the remaining
18 parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

19
20 **SEC. 5.** All laws, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations, inconsistent with
21 this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

22
23 **SEC. 6.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
24 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
