AN ACT
INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE LINGAYEN DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN
THE MUNICIPALITY OF LINGAYEN, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN FROM SIXTY
(60) TO ONE HUNDRED (100) BEDS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** The authorized bed capacity of the Lingayen District Hospital in the
2 Municipality of Lingayen, Province of Pangasinan is hereby increased from sixty (60) to
3 one hundred (100) beds. Any future increase in bed capacity shall be consistent with its
4 hospital development plan which shall be prepared by the Chief of Hospital of the
5 Lingayen District Hospital.

7 **SEC. 2.** The existing professional health care services and facilities shall also be
8 upgraded to conform with and be commensurate to the bed capacity increase as
9 provided for in Section 1 hereof.

10
11 **SEC. 3.** The existing workforce of the Lingayen District Hospital, which includes
12 doctors, nurses and support personnel, shall also be increased correspondingly.

13
14 **SEC. 4.** The Provincial Government of Pangasinan shall provide the necessary
15 funds to support the increase in bed capacity of the Lingayen District Hospital and the
16 corresponding upgrading of its facilities and services.

18 **SEC. 5.** The Secretary of the Department of Health (DOH) shall include in the
19 DOH's subsidy program its support for the capital outlay requirements of the hospital.

20
21 **SEC. 6.** If any provision or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the
22 remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

1 **SEC. 7.** All laws, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations, inconsistent
2 with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
3

4 **SEC. 8.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
5 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
