Recommending the approval of House Bill No. 9820 with amendments, taking into consideration Senate Bill No. 2309

Sponsor: Senator Francis "Tol" N. Tolentino

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Local Government; and Electoral Reforms and People's Participation, to which were referred **House Bill No. 9820**, introduced by Representatives Alan "Aldu" R. Dujali, Sandro L. Gonzalez, and Macnell M. Lusotan, entitled:

"AN ACT

SEPARATING THE SITIO OF TULALIAN FROM BARANGAY BALAGUNAN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF STO. TOMAS, PROVINCE OF DAVAO DEL NORTE, AND CONSTITUTING IT INTO A DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY TULALIAN"

taking into consideration **Senate Bill No. 2309**, introduced by Senator Imee R. Marcos, entitled:

**"AN ACT
CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY TULALIAN IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF STO. TOMAS, PROVINCE OF DAVAO DEL NORTE"**

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 9820, taking into consideration Senate Bill No. 2309, be approved with the following amendments:

1. On page 1, line 2, delete the word "Sto." and replace it with "**SANTO**";
2. On page 2, lines 9 to 11, delete entire Section 6, and replace with a new Section 6, to read thus:


"SEC. 6. NATIONAL TAX ALLOTMENT SHARES. – BARANGAY TULALIAN SHALL BE ENTITLED TO AN ALLOTMENT DERIVED FROM NATIONAL TAXES PURSUANT TO SECTION 285 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, AS AMENDED."

3. Finally, to change the title of the Bill to read, thus:

**"AN ACT
SEPARATING THE SITIO OF TULALIAN FROM BARANGAY BALAGUNAN
IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SANTO TOMAS, PROVINCE OF DAVAO DEL
NORTE, AND CONSTITUTING IT INTO A DISTINCT AND
INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY TULALIAN"**

AN ACT

SEPARATING THE SITIO OF TULALIAN FROM BARANGAY BALAGUNAN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF STO. TOMAS, PROVINCE OF DAVAO DEL NORTE, AND CONSTITUTING IT INTO A DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY TULALIAN

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives
of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 **SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Tulalian.*** – The sitio of Tulalian is hereby separated from
2 Barangay Balagunan in the Municipality of Sto. Tomas, Province of Davao del Norte and
3 constituted as a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay Tulalian.

4 **SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.*** – The territorial boundaries of Barangay Tulalian are hereby
5 described as follows:

6 “Beginning at a point marked “1” on the plan

7 Being N 85 deg. – 00’ E, 8,020 m. to point 2;
8 Thence N 02 deg. - 50’ W, 1,300 m. to point 3;
9 Thence S 88” deg. - 50’ W, 8,005 m. to point 4;
10 Thence S 03 deg. - 00’ E, 1,900 m. to point beginning;

11 Containing an area of approximately One thousand two hundred eighty -
12 two (1,282) hectares.”

13 **SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.*** – The plebiscite conducted and supervised
14 by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 007-94, Series
15 of 1994 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Davao del Norte, which ratified the
16 creation of Barangay Tulalian as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on October 23,

1 1994 shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of
2 the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended.

3 **SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.*** – The incumbent elected barangay officials of
4 Barangay Tulalian shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been
5 duly elected and qualified.

6 **SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.*** – All public infrastructure and facilities existing
7 therein at the time of the approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or
8 compensation to and shall be administered by the new Barangay Tulalian.

9 **SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.*** – Barangay Tulalian shall be entitled to
10 internal revenue allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of the Local Government Code
11 of 1991, as amended.

12 **SEC. 7. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
13 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
