Submitted by the Committees on Local Government; and Electoral Reforms and People's Participation on MAY 18 2022.

Re: House Bill No. 7775

Recommending the approval of House Bill No. 7775, with amendments.

Sponsor: Senator Francis "Tol" N. Tolentino

**MR. PRESIDENT:**

The Committees on Local Government; and Electoral Reforms and People's Participation, to which were referred **House Bill No. 7775**, introduced by Representative Frederick W. Siao, entitled:

**"AN ACT  
CREATING BARANGAYS ACMAC, DITUCALAN, SAN ROQUE,  
LUINAB, UPPER HINAPLANON, AND UBALDO LAYA, ALL IN THE  
CITY OF ILIGAN"**

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 7775 be approved with the following amendments:

1. An omnibus amendment, replace the name "Acmac" with "**ACMAC-MARIANO BADELLES SR.:**"
  - On page 1, lines 1, 3 and 7; and
  - On page 3, line 69.
2. On page 1, line 3, delete the name "Barangay Ditucalan,";
3. Still on page 1, line 13, up to page 2, line 26, delete the entire paragraph (2) of Section 2, and re-number the succeeding subsections accordingly;
4. On Page 2, line 46, delete one double quotation mark (") before the word "Bounded";
5. On page 3, lines 60 to 61, delete the phrase "1821 dated November 18, 1988 for the creation of Barangay Ditucalan,";
6. Still on page 3, line 69, delete the word "Ditucalan,";
7. Still on page 3, lines 74 to 77, delete entire Section 6, and replace with a new Section 6, to read thus:


**"SEC. 6. NATIONAL TAX ALLOTMENT SHARES. – BARANGAYS ACMAC-MARIANO BADELLES SR., SAN ROQUE, LUINAB, UPPER HINAPLANON, AND UBALDO LAYA SHALL BE ENTITLED TO AN ALLOTMENT DERIVED FROM NATIONAL TAXES PURSUANT TO SECTION 285 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7160, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, AS AMENDED."** and

8. Finally, to change the title of the Bill to read, thus:

**"AN ACT  
CREATING BARANGAYS ACMAC-MARIANO BADELLES SR., SAN  
ROQUE, LUIBAB, UPPER HINAPLANON, AND UBALDO LAYA, ALL IN  
THE CITY OF ILIGAN"**

AN ACT  
CREATING BARANGAYS ACMAC, DITUCALAN, SAN ROQUE, LUINAB, UPPER HINAPLANON,  
AND UBALDO LAYA, ALL IN THE CITY OF ILIGAN

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives  
of the Philippines In Congress assembled:*

1           **SECTION 1.** *Creation of Barangays Acmac, Ditucalan, San Roque, Luinab, Upper*  
2 *Hinaplanon, and Ubaldo Laya* – There shall be created six (6) barangays in the City of Iligan to  
3 be known as Barangay Acmac, Barangay Ditucalan, Barangay San Roque, Barangay Luinab,  
4 Barangay Upper Hinaplanon, and Barangay Ubaldo Laya.

5           **SEC. 2. Territorial Boundaries.** – The territorial boundaries of each barangay created in  
6 the preceding section are hereby described as follows:

7           **(1) Barangay Acmac**

8                           “Bounded on the Northwest by Iligan Bay and Matuog Creek;  
9                           On the Northeast by Matuog Creek, Lots Numbered 5229, 3312, 3314 and 3298;  
10                          On the Southeast by a creek and Lots Numbered 3295, 3281 and 3162; and  
11                          On the Southwest by Lot 3162 and a creek, containing an area of more or less  
12                          one hundred nine hectares and seventy eight square meters (109.78).”

13           **(2) Barangay Ditucalan**

14                          “Bounded on the Northeast by Agus River;  
15                          On the South by Linamon River;  
16                          On the East by Barangay Maria Cristina; and  
17                          On the West by Cadastral Lots Numbered 2054, 2047, 2001, 2015, 4150, 4154,  
18                          2343, 2341, 2124, 2338, 2016, 2017, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2007, 2019, 2020, 2021,

19 2023, 2022, 2024, 2025, 2048, 2049, 2258, 2277, 2265, 2263, 2264, 2303, 2305,  
20 2220, 2227, 2230, 2231, 2235, 2236, 2237, 2232, 2260, 2272, 2271, 2270, 2269,  
21 2268, 2267, 2275, 2276, 2273, 2298, 2296, 2295, 2294, 2288, 2289, 2286, 2299,  
22 2285, 2302, 2300, 2301, 2316, 2314, 2310, 2311, 2312, 2313, 2331, 2325, 2324,  
23 2323, 2322, 2321, 2320, 2329, 2330, 2332, 2333, 2334, 2335, 2307, 2413, 4151,  
24 4152, 4155, 4410, 4420, 4492, 4491, 4490, 4489, 4349, 2529, 2559, 2753, 2752,  
25 2874, containing an area of more or less seventy seven hectares and five  
26 thousand six hundred forty three square meters (77.5643).”

27 **(3) Barangay San Roque**

28 “Bounded on the Northwest by Lots Numbered 1912, 2937, 1911, 1917, 2941,  
29 1934, 1933, 1931, 3400 and 3162;  
30 On the Northeast by Lots Numbered 3500, 3458, 3296, 3161, and 3159, and  
31 Mandulog River;  
32 On the Southeast by Mandulog River; and  
33 On the Southwest by a new bridge, Mandulog River and the new National  
34 Highway, containing an area of more or less one hundred thirty one hectares and  
35 sixty two square meters (131.62).”

36 **(4) Barangay Luinab**

37 “Bounded on the North by Lots Numbered 1342, portion, 1349 portion, 1341,  
38 1350, 1327, 3128, 3145 and 4730;  
39 On the South by Lots Numbered 1386, 1414, 1402, 3030, 3034, 4278, 3035,  
40 3062;  
41 On the East by Lots Numbered 5057, 3058, 3146 and 3061; and  
42 On the West by Manggas Creek, containing an area of more or less two hundred  
43 ninety three hectares and seven hundred twenty eight square meters  
44 (293.728).”

45 **(5) Barangay Upper Hinaplanon**

46 ““Bounded on the Northwest by Mandulog River;  
47 On the Northeast by Mandulog River;  
48 On the Southeast by Barangay Mandulog Lots Numbered 3147, 3146, 3058 and  
49 5057; and  
50 On the Southwest by Lots Numbered 3055, 2284, 3057, 3053, 1863, 3127, 1864,  
51 1872 and 1874, containing an area of more or less one hundred ninety hectares  
52 and nine hundred twenty seven square meters (190.927).”

53 **(6) Barangay Ubaldo Laya**



54 "Bounded on the Northeast by Badelles Street Extension and Lots Numbered  
55 1485, 1484, 1524, 1537, 1556, 5347, 5349 and 1559;  
56 On the Northwest by Mahayahay, La Salle Road, and portion of Roxas Avenue;  
57 On the Southwest by Iligan River; and  
58 On the Southeast by Tipanoy River."

59 **SEC. 3. Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.** – The plebiscite conducted and  
60 supervised by the Commission on Elections pursuant to Iligan City Ordinance Numbered 1821  
61 dated November 18, 1988 for the creation of Barangay Ditucalan, 1934 dated February 5, 1991  
62 for the creation of Barangay Luinab, 1945 dated March 20, 1991 for the creation of Barangay  
63 Upper Hinaplanon, 1931, 1932 and 1946 all dated July 22, 1991 for the creation of Barangay  
64 Acmac, Barangay San Roque and Barangay Ubaldo Laya respectively, which ratified the creation  
65 of said barangays as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers shall serve as substantial  
66 compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160,  
67 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended.

68 **SEC. 4. Incumbent Barangay Officials.** – The incumbent barangay officials of Barangays  
69 Acmac, Ditucalan, San Roque, Luinab, Upper Hinaplanon, and Ubaldo Laya shall continue to  
70 hold office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

71 **SEC. 5. Public Infrastructure and Facilities.** – All existing public infrastructure and  
72 facilities for public use within the territorial boundaries of the newly-created barangays shall  
73 continue to be owned and administered by them.

74 **SEC. 6. Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) Shares.** – Barangays Acmac, Ditucalan, San  
75 Roque, Luinab, Upper Hinaplanon, and Ubaldo Laya Acmac shall be entitled to Internal Revenue  
76 Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as  
77 the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended.

78 **SEC. 7. Repealing Clause.** – All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations  
79 contrary to or inconsistent with any provision of this Act are hereby repealed or amended  
80 accordingly.

81 **SEC. 8. Effectivity.** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the  
82 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general application.
