AN ACT

CREATING A BARANGAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN LUIS, PROVINCE OF AGUSAN DEL SUR,  
TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY DOÑA MAXIMA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1           **SECTION 1. Creation of Barangay Dona Maxima.** – There is hereby created a barangay  
2 in the Municipality of San Luis, Province of Agusan del Sur, to be known as Barangay Doña  
3 Maxima.

4           **SEC. 2. Territorial Boundaries.** – The territorial boundaries of Barangay Doña Maxima are  
5 hereby described as follows:

1-2	S 67 deg. 04'E	696.91 meters
2-3	N 26 deg. 39'E	1788.45 meters
3-4	S 15 deg. 58'E	999.86 meters
4-5	S 07 deg. 38'E	1580.14 meters
5-6	S 73 deg. 07'W	1223.14 meters
6-7	S 47 deg. 38'W	1284.50 meters
7-8	N 09 deg. 45'W	279.13 meters
8-1	N 29 deg. 47'E	478.46 meters

Lot	Bearing	Distance
Case 2	N 66 deg. 57'E	9431.46 meters

1           **SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.*** – The plebiscite conducted and supervised  
2 by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 07, Series of  
3 1991 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Agusan del Sur, which ratified the  
4 creation of Barangay Doña Maxima as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on  
5 December 19, 1998 shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under  
6 Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, as  
7 amended.

8           **SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.*** – The incumbent barangay officials of Barangay  
9 Doña Maxima shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been duly  
10 elected and qualified.

11           **SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.*** – All public infrastructure and facilities for  
12 public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act shall continue to be owned and  
13 administered by Barangay Doña Maxima.

14           **SEC. 6. *National Tax Allotment (NTA) Shares.*** – Barangay Doña Maxima shall be entitled  
15 to National Tax Allotment (NTA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as  
16 amended.

17           **SEC. 7. *Repealing Clause.*** – All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations  
18 contrary to or inconsistent with any provision of this Act are hereby repealed or amended  
19 accordingly.

20           **SEC. 8. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the  
21 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general application.
