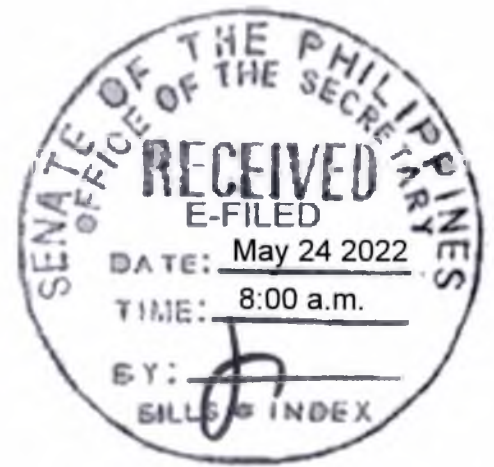

RESOLUTION

COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE PHILIPPINE DELEGATION TO THE 31ST SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES (SEA GAMES) HELD IN HANOI, VIETNAM FROM MAY 12 TO 23, 2022 FOR ABLY REPRESENTING THE NATION AND BRINGING HONOR AND PRIDE TO THE COUNTRY

1 WHEREAS, the Senate of the Philippines has, on numerous occasions,
2 recognized outstanding Filipinos for their remarkable achievements in international
3 sports competitions and for bringing honor and pride to the country;

4 WHEREAS, the Southeast Asian (SEA) Games is a biennial regional multi-sport
5 event under the regulation of the Southeast Asian Games Federation with supervision
6 by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and the Olympic Council of Asia (OCA).
7 The 31st edition of the SEA Games was held from May 12 to 23, 2022 in Hanoi,
8 Vietnam, which hosted 40 sports, mostly Olympic games;

9 WHEREAS, the Philippines sent a 981 person-strong delegation, composed of
10 641 Filipino athletes and Olympians from 38 sports, 318 officials and 18 support staff;

12 WHEREAS, in the 2021 SEA Games, the Philippines garnered 226 medals – 52
13 gold, 70 silver and 104 bronze medals – thus placing fourth overall among the eleven
14 nations who competed in the regional sports event;

15 WHEREAS, the Philippines' overall performance is its strongest showing in the
16 games which it did not host since 2003, and the most productive in terms of medal
17 haul since 2009;

1 WHEREAS, the Filipino athletes showed their prowess and ably represented the
2 country in their respective sports events, with 53 of them winning multiple medals,
3 led by Carlos Yulo who won five gold medals and two silver medals in gymnastics,
4 while some even setting new national and Southeast Asian records;

5 Whereas, the athletes prepared and trained for the regional meet amidst the
6 limitations and health risks posed by the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, thereby
7 demonstrating their discipline, patriotism and commitment to represent the country
8 well as its flag-bearers in the international arena;

9 Whereas, the Philippine delegation collectively brought honor and pride to the
10 country and served as inspiration for the younger generation to enter into sports which
11 foster self-discipline, teamwork and excellence;

12 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Senate, to
13 commend and congratulate the Philippine delegation to the 31st Southeast Asian
14 Games (SEA Games) held in Hanoi, Vietnam from May 12 to 23, 2022 for ably
15 representing the nation and bringing honor and pride to the country.
