## RESOLUTION

RECOMMENDING THE CREATION OF A TASK FORCE TO ADDRESS AND COMBAT THE SPREAD OF MONKEYPOX DISEASE WITH THE END IN VIEW OF A MORE COMPREHENSIVE AND HOLISTIC GOVERNMENTAL APPROACH

WHEREAS, the US Center for Disease Control and Prevention describes the
Monkeypox Disease as a rare kind of infection caused by a virus belonging to the
family of viruses that also causes smallpox;<sup>1</sup>

WHEREAS, the first recorded case of Monkeypox in humans was in 1970. Cases were usually in Central and Western African countries;<sup>2</sup>

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization considers the Monkeypox as a disease of global health importance<sup>3</sup> and a public health emergency of international concern;

WHEREAS, recently, the Philippines has detected its first case of Monkeypox. "The case is a 31-year-old Filipino national who arrived from abroad last July 19. The case had prior travel to countries with documented Monkeypox cases. The case was tested and confirmed positive for Monkeypox via Reverse Transcriptase Polymerase Chain Reaction or RT-PCR, done at the DOH Research Institute for Tropical Medicine

WHEREAS, there is also a reported case of a 31-year old Filipino who tested positive in Singapore;<sup>5</sup>

WHEREAS, it is imperative that we implement a more comprehensive and holistic approach in addressing and combatting the spread of the Monkeypox disease;

WHEREAS, a Task Force may be helpful in planning and implementing a more organized and objective strategy towards preventing an uncontrollable and unmanageable spread of the disease;

WHEREAS, in our efforts to comply with our responsibilities under the Constitution that "the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them,", all means should be exhausted to effectively and efficiently address this disease;

WHEREAS, it is vital that we arrest the threat before it becomes of such magnitude that it is already beyond control. We have to learn from the past, and use to our advantage the lessons of this recent COVID-19 pandemic which we are still experiencing now;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to recommend the creation of a task force to address and combat the spread of Monkeypox disease with the end in view of a more comprehensive and holistic governmental approach.
