AN ACT

ESTABLISHING A CAMPUS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY OF SOUTHERN PHILIPPINES (USTSP) IN BARANGAY BALUBAL, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, TO BE KNOWN AS THE USTSP-BARANGAY BALUBAL, CAGAYAN DE ORO CAMPUS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The University of Science and Technology of Southern Philippines (USTSP) is a state university established on August 16, 2016 by virtue of Republic Act No. 10919 through the amalgamation of the Mindanao University of Science and Technology (MUST) in Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental and the Misamis Oriental State College of Agriculture and Technology (MOSCAT) in Claveria, Misamis Oriental. Both campuses are located in Northern Mindanao, the gateway to Mindanao, which offers a strategic location to train and develop students from all the other regions in Mindanao.¹ It has satellite campuses in Jasaan, Misamis Oriental, and Panaon and Oroquieta, Misamis Occidental. A satellite campus in Barangay Balubal,

Cagayan de Oro City will further serve the youth of the eastern part of the 2nd District of Cagayan de Oro City.²

This bill seeks to establish a campus which shall be headed by a Campus Administrator. The provisions of R.A. No. 8292, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Modernization Act of 1997", shall form part of this Act and shall serve as the governing charter of the University. All assets, personnel and records of the proposed campus, as well as its liabilities, shall be named after the state college and should the campus cease to exist, it shall revert to the concerned local government unit or the Republic of the Philippines, as the case may be. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

In view of the foregoing, approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

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ESTABLISHING A CAMPUS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY OF SOUTHERN PHILIPPINES (USTSP) IN BARANGAY BALUBAL, CAGAYAN DE ORO CITY, TO BE KNOWN AS THE USTSP-BARANGAY BALUBAL, CAGAYAN DE ORO CAMPUS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. This Act shall be known as the "University of Science and
 Technology of Southern Philippines (USTSP)-Barangay Balubal, Cagayan de
 Oro Campus Act".

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5 Sec. 2. There is hereby established a campus of the University of 6 Science and Technology of Southern Philippines (USTSP), hereinafter referred 7 to as the University, in Barangay Balubal, Cagayan De Oro City, to be known 8 as the USTSP-Barangay Balubal, Cagayan de Oro Campus.

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Sec. 3. The USTSP-Barangay Balubal, Cagayan de Oro Campus shall
 primarily provide short-term technical-vocational, undergraduate, and

graduate courses within its areas of competency and specialization, pursuant
 to its mandate, and according to its capabilities as the Board of Regents,
 hereinafter referred to as the Board, may deem necessary to carry out its
 objectives, and those which respond to the human resources development
 needs of Cagayan De Oro City and Region X.

6 The USTSP-Barangay Balubal, Cagayan de Oro Campus is also 7 mandated to undertake research and extension services and provide 8 progressive leadership in these areas.

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10 Sec. 4. The USTSP-Barangay Balubal, Cagayan de Oro Campus shall 11 be headed by a Campus Administrator who shall render full-time service and 12 shall be appointed or designated by the Board upon the recommendation of 13 the search committee and the President of the University. Such appointment 14 or designation shall be subject to the guidelines, qualifications and standards 15 set by the Board.

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Sec. 5. The establishment of the USTSP-Barangay Balubal, Cagayan de
Oro Campus shall comply with the minimum requirements for its operation
and program offerings as duly prescribed by the Commission on Higher
Education.

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Sec. 6. All assets, real and personal, personnel, and records of the USTSP-Barangay Balubal, Cagayan de Oro Campus, as well as liabilities or obligations, are hereby transferred to the University. The positions, rights, and security of tenure of faculty members and personnel employed at the USTSP-Barangay Balubal, Cagayan de Oro Campus under existing laws prior to the integration to the university shall be respected.

All parcels of land belonging to the government occupied by the USTSP-Barangay Balubal, Cagayan de Oro Campus are hereby declared to be the property of the University and shall be titled under that name: *Provided*, That should the University cease to exist or be abolished, or should such aforementioned parcels of land be no longer needed by the University, the
 same shall revert to the concerned LGU or to the Republic of the Philippines,
 as the case may be.

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Sec. 7. The provisions of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as
the "Higher Education Modernization Act of 1997", shall form an integral part
of this Act, and together, shall serve as the governing charter of the University.

9 Sec. 8. All other powers, functions, privileges, responsibilities, and 10 limitations to state universities and its officials under existing laws shall be 11 deemed granted to or imposed upon the University and its officials, whenever 12 appropriate.

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Sec. 9. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Actshall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

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Sec. 10. If any provision or part of this Act is declared invalid or
unconstitutional, the remaining provisions or parts not affected shall remain
in full force and effect.

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Sec. 11. All laws, executive orders, presidential decrees, administrative orders, rules and regulations, issuances, or parts thereof inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

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Sec. 12. Notwithstanding the non-issuance of the IRR, this Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
