AN ACT AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7104, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS 'COMMISSION ON THE FILIPINO LANGUAGE ACT' AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 9 Article XIV of the 1987 Constitution states, "The Congress shall establish a national language commission composed of representatives of various regions and disciplines which shall undertake, coordinate, and promote research for the development, propagation, and preservation of Filipino and other languages."

Committed to making the Filipino language an effective instrument of national development, Congress enacted Republic Act No. 7104, creating the Commission on the Filipino Language, known today as the "Komisyon sa Wikang Filipino (KWF)."

This measure aims to amend certain provisions of RA 7104, otherwise known as "An Act Creating the Commission on the Filipino Language, Prescribing its Powers, Duties and Functions, Appropriating Funds Therefor and For Other Purposes," to intensify appreciation of the Filipino language, uphold and safeguard it as the country's national language, as well as intensify the work of the KWF.

Languages are a vital part of our heritage and national identity. As a sign of respect for our history and culture, the Constitutional policy for Filipino as the official

language and language of instruction should be implemented and promulgated. The KWF should carry out measures to further enrich the Filipino language.

In view of the foregoing, the approval of this measure is earnestly sought.

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AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7104, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS 'COMMISSION ON THE FILIPINO LANGUAGE ACT' AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Republic of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Short title. This Act shall be known as the "Komisyon sa Wikang 1 Filipino (Commission on the Filipino Language) Act." 2 3 Sec. 2. Section 2 of the Komisyon sa Wikang Filipino (Commission on the Filipino Language) Act is amended to read as follows: 4 5 Section 2. Declaration of Policy Pursuant to the mandate of the Constitution, AND AS ENABLING LAW OF 6 SECTION 6 ARTICLE XIV ON LANGUAGE 7 OF CONSTITUTION, it is hereby declared to be a policy of the Government to 8 TAKE STEPS TO INITIATE AND SUSTAIN THE USE OF FILIPINO AS 9 MEDIUM OF OFFICIAL COMMUNICATION AND AS LANGUAGE OF 10 INSTRUCTION IN THE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM THROUGH THE 11 PROMOTION, EVOLUTION, DEVELOPMENT, 12 AND ENRICHMENT OF FILIPINO AS THE NATIONAL LANGUAGE. TO THIS 13 END, THE GOVERNMENT, AS SPEARHEADED BY KOMISYON SA 14 WIKANG FILIPINO (COMMISSION ON THE FILIPINO LANGUAGE), 15 SHALL TAKE THE NECESSARY STEPS TO CARRY OUT THE SAID 16 POLICY. 17

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION - REFERS TO A LANGUAGE 22 ADOPTED BY THE LEARNING INSTITUTION 23 LANGUAGE THAT IT USES IN ITS **EDUCATIONAL** 24 INSTRUCTION 25 SYSTEM OF EDUCATION - REFERS TO ALL LEVELS OF EDUCATION, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, BASIC 26 27 EDUCATION, SECONDARY EDUCATION, AND TERTIARY 28 EDUCATION. 29 k. ENDANGERED LANGUAGE - REFERS TO A PHILIPPINE LANGUAGE THAT IS AT RISK OF VANISHING ACCORDING TO 30 31 FACTORS SET OUT BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.
