





**AN ACT
STRENGTHENING THE MECHANISM FOR LAND USE DEVELOPMENT AND
INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING AND BUDGETING FOR STATE UNIVERSITIES
AND COLLEGES, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11396,
OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "SUCS LAND USE DEVELOPMENT AND
INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN (LUDIP) ACT"**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Republic Act No. 11396 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 "Sec. 3. *Preparation and Implementation of the LUDIP in SUCs.*
4 – All state universities and colleges (SUCs), through their governing
5 boards, shall be required to prepare and implement a LUDIP designed
6 to improve and optimally utilize their resources. All land use [of] **AND**
7 **PRIORITY** infrastructure projects [of] **TO BE IMPLEMENTED BY**
8 the SUCs [~~shall also be required to follow the LUDIP, which~~] **WITHIN**
9 **A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THEIR**
10 **RESPECTIVE LUDIP: PROVIDED, THAT THE LUDIP** shall be
11 linked with the land use plan and practice of the local government
12 units **HAVING TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OVER THE SUC**

1 **CONCERNED** to ensure complementation of activities across
2 geographical boundaries.

3 “The LUDIP shall be submitted by the SUCs to the Commission
4 on Higher Education (CHED) within two (2) years after the approval of
5 this Act: *Provided*, That it shall be **REVIEWED AND** updated
6 ~~[periodically as the need arises]~~ **EVERY FIVE (5) YEARS BY THE**
7 **GOVERNING BOARDS OF THE SUCS**~~[: *Provided, further*, That the~~
8 ~~CHED shall be informed of changes made thereof: *Provided, finally*,~~
9 ~~That it should be reviewed by the governing board ten (10) years after~~
10 ~~its approval]~~ to ensure that it remains relevant and in consonance with
11 current conditions and realities.

12 “The preparation and implementation of the LUDIP shall be
13 made a requirement for the approval of infrastructure projects in
14 SUCs. No new infrastructure project shall be approved and
15 implemented in any SUC unless the LUDIP has been implemented and
16 submitted to the CHED. **THE IMPLEMENTATION OF LAND USE**
17 **AND INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS OF THE SUCS SHALL BE**
18 **MONITORED BY AN INTER-AGENCY COMMITTEE TO BE**
19 **COMPOSED OF THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE CHED, AND THE**
20 **SECRETARIES OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT, PUBLIC**
21 **WORKS AND HIGHWAYS, AND SOCIOECONOMIC PLANNING,**
22 **OR THEIR RESPECTIVE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES.**

23 **“THE CHED SHALL INCLUDE THE LUDIP OF EACH SUC IN**
24 **A FIVE- (5-) YEAR COMPREHENSIVE LUDIP FOR ALL**
25 **COMPLIANT SUCS WITHIN ONE (1) YEAR FROM THE RECEIPT**
26 **THEREOF. THE COMPREHENSIVE LUDIP SHALL CONTAIN,**
27 **AMONG OTHERS, A LISTING OF LAND USE AND**
28 **INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS TO BE IMPLEMENTED BY THE**
29 **SUCS AND THEIR RESPECTIVE FUNDING REQUIREMENTS. THE**
30 **CHED SHALL SUBMIT THE COMPREHENSIVE LUDIP TO**
31 **CONGRESS AND OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES CONCERNED**

1 **TO GUIDE THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR THE LAND USE**
2 **AND INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS OF THE SUCS ON AN**
3 **ANNUAL BASIS.**

4 Sec. 2. A new Section 7 shall be inserted after Section 6 of Republic Act No.
5 11396 to read as follows:

6 **"SEC. 7. APPROPRIATIONS. – THE AMOUNT NECESSARY**
7 **FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LAND USE AND**
8 **INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS INCLUDED IN THE**
9 **COMPREHENSIVE LUDIP AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 3 OF THIS**
10 **ACT SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE ANNUAL GENERAL**
11 **APPROPRIATIONS OF THE RESPECTIVE SUCS."**

12 The succeeding sections of Republic Act No. 11396 are hereby renumbered
13 accordingly.

14 Sec. 3. Section 7 of Republic Act No. 11396 is hereby renumbered as Section
15 8 and amended to read as follows:

16 "Sec. ~~[7.]~~ **8. Implementing Rules and Regulations.** – Within
17 ~~[sixty (60)]~~ **THIRTY (30)** days after the effectivity of this Act, the
18 CHED, in coordination with the Philippine Association of State
19 Universities and Colleges, ~~[the]~~**THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET**
20 **AND MANAGEMENT, DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SETTLEMENTS**
21 **AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT,** the DPWH, ~~[HLURB,]~~ **NATIONAL**
22 **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY,** LMB-DENR and other
23 relevant government agencies and stakeholders, shall formulate the
24 necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this
25 Act."

26 Sec. 4. *Separability Clause.* – If any provision or part hereof is declared
27 unconstitutional, the remainder of this Act or any provision not affected thereby shall
28 remain in full force and effect.

1 Sec. 5. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, acts, decrees, executive orders,
2 issuances, and rules and regulations or parts thereof which are contrary to and
3 inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

4 Sec. 6. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect immediately following its
5 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in at least two (2) newspapers of general
6 circulation.
