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**AN ACT**

**CREATING A BARANGAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF NORZAGARAY, PROVINCE OF BULACAN TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY FRIENDSHIP VILLAGE RESOURCES OR BARANGAY FVR**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           **SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Friendship Village Resources.*** – There is hereby  
2        created a barangay in the Municipality of Norzagaray, Province of Bulacan, to be known as  
3        Barangay Friendship Village Resources or “Barangay FVR.”

4           **SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.*** – The territorial boundaries of Barangay FVR are hereby  
5        described as follows:

6        ~~[“Bounded on the North by a Creek; On the East by Lot No. 2451; on the South by  
7        a Concrete Barangay Road; on the Southeast by the City of San Jose del Monte; and  
8        on the West by Lots Numbered 2458, 2459, 2542 and 2436.”]~~

**Area:** FIVE HUNDRED ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR (501,484) SQUARE METERS more or less.

**Description of Corners:** All points referred to on plan and are marked on the ground as follows: pts. 1 to 20 by Old Pls Cyl. Conc. Mons. 15 by 80 cm., pts. 20 to 36 by Stake, pts. 36 to 47 by Old Pls Cyl. Conc. Mons. 15 by 80 cm.

9                   **SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.*** – The plebiscite conducted and supervised  
10 by the Commission on Election pursuant to *Sangguniang Panlalawigan* Ordinance No. 003, which  
11 was duly ratified and proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on October 12, 2002 shall  
12 serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act  
13 No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

14                   **SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.*** – The incumbent elected barangay officials of  
15 Barangay FVR shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been duly  
16 elected and qualified.

17                   **SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructures and Facilities.*** – All public infrastructures and facilities  
18 existing in Barangay FVR at the time of the approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost  
19 or compensation to and shall be administered by the new barangay.

20           **SEC. 6. *National Tax Allotment Shares.*** – Barangay FVR shall be entitled to National Tax  
21       Allotment shares pursuant to Section 285 of the Local Government Code of 1991, as amended.

22           **SEC. 7. *Repealing Clause.*** – All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules, regulations, which  
23       are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

24           **SEC. 8. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the  
25       *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
