## **AN ACT**

## DECLARING THE BAGACAY POINT LIGHTHOUSE, LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LILOAN, PROVINCE OF CEBU, A TOURISM DESTINATION

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Bagacay Point Lighthouse located in the Municipality of Liloan,
 Province of Cebu, is hereby declared a tourism destination. Pursuant thereto, its development
 shall be prioritized and supported by the Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules
 and regulations governing the development of tourism destinations.

5 SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the municipal government of 6 Liloan shall, in coordination with the DOT and concerned agencies of the government, prepare 7 a tourism development plan that shall include the construction, installation and maintenance of 8 such appropriate infrastructure and facilities to enhance tourism in the area: *Provided*, That 9 said development plan shall ensure the preservation of the historical significance of the area: 10 *Provided, further,* That the implementation of the tourism development plan shall be included 11 in the budget of the municipal government of Liloan. SEC. 3. The DOT shall assist the municipal government of Liloan in the implementation
 of the tourism development plan by providing technical assistance in tourism capacity building.
 It shall also include the Bagacay Point Lighthouse in its national and regional promotion
 programs.

SEC. 4. The funding for the implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual
budget of the municipal government of Liloan. The DOT may augment such allocation with
internally-generated funds.

8 SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the municipal 9 government of Liloan shall, in consultation with the DOT and concerned agencies of the 10 government, promulgate rules and regulations to implement this Act.

SEC. 6. All laws, rules, regulations, presidential decrees and other issuances
 inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby deemed repealed or amended
 accordingly.

SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
