RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INVESTIGATION, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH PROMPTED THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) TO ISSUE A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AGAINST GENTLE HANDS INC. WITH THE END IN VIEW OF AMENDING OR PASSING LAWS WHICH WILL STRENGTHEN THE SPECIAL PROTECTION GRANTED TO CHILDREN BY THE 1987 CONSTITUTION AND OTHER VARIOUS LAWS

1 WHEREAS, Section 3 (2), Article XV of our 1987 Constitution states 2 that "The State shall defend the right of children to assistance, including proper 3 care and nutrition, and special protection from all forms of neglect, abuse, 4 cruelty, exploitation and other conditions prejudicial to their development"; 5

6 WHEREAS, Consistent with our Constitution, Article 1, Section 2 of the 7 Republic Act No. 7610 or the Special Protection of Children Against Abuse. Exploitation and Discrimination Act provides that it is the policy of the State to 8 9 provide special protection to children from all forms of abuse, neglect, cruelty exploitation and discrimination and other conditions, prejudicial to their 10 development; provide sanctions for their commission and carry out a program for 11 12 prevention and deterrence of and crisis intervention in situations of child abuse, 13 exploitation and discrimination;

15 WHEREAS, the Department of Social Welfare and Development 16 (DSWD) is the primary government agency mandated to develop, implement, 17 and coordinate social protection and poverty-reduction solutions for and with the 18 poor, vulnerable, and disadvantaged;

WHEREAS, it is reported that on May 20, 2023, DSWD Secretary Rex
 Gatchalian conducted a surprise visit to the Gentle Hands Inc., a private
 orphanage in Quezon City, following an alleged complaint that said orphanage
 had violated Republic Act No. 7610 or the Special Protection of Children Against
 Child Abuse, Exploitation and Discrimination;

7 WHEREAS, during said surprise visit, the DSWD Secretary allegedly
8 determined that the children are in "imminent danger" and decided that it is in the
9 best interest of the children to be immediately transferred to a safer shelter;

WHEREAS, in the evening of May 22, 2023, the DSWD issued a cease and desist order against Gentle Hands Inc., and the following day, the Gentle Hands children were reportedly gathered and transferred without notice to Elsie Gaches Village in Alabang, Nayong Kabataan in Mandaluyong, and the Reception and Study Center For Children in Quezon City;¹

WHEREAS, the Commission on Human Rights expressed concern that
the children involved may have been traumatized and that it is crucial that the risk
of further trauma, hurt, or harm to children when conducting investigative and
intervention processes be minimized;

WHEREAS, reports indicate that the already distressing situation was exacerbated by the fact that some officials and police officers present when the children were gathered were armed, causing additional distress among the children;²

WHEREAS, Gentle Hands Inc. Executive Director Charity Heppner Graff
 expressed that the alleged violations are not enough reason to forcibly move the
 children out of the facility;³

WHEREAS, it is reported that no prior notice was given when the DSWD
 served the cease and desist order and that Gentle Hands Inc. is now considering
 to secure a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) against the DSWD's action
 which resulted in the displacement of the children;

WHEREAS, this incident involving Gentle Hands Inc. orphanage presents
 Congress with compelling legislative policy issues in protecting the rights and
 welfare of children;

1 2 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED 3 by the Senate of the Philippines, to direct the appropriate Senate committee to conduct an investigation, in aid of legislation, on the incident regarding Gentle 4 5 Hands Inc. which prompted the Department of Social Welfare and Development 6 (DSWD) to issue a cease and desist order, with the end view of amending and passing laws which will strengthen the special protection granted to children by 7 8 the 1987 Constitution and other various laws. 9
