AN ACT

ESTABLISHING IN THE CITY OF LUCENA, PROVINCE OF QUEZON, A GENERAL HOSPITAL TO BE KNOWN AS THE LUCENA CITY HOSPITAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established in the City of Lucena, Province of Quezon, a
 [tertiary] LEVEL 1 GENERAL hospital, WITH A CAPACITY OF ONE HUNDRED (100)
 BEDS, to be known as the Lucena City Hospital, which shall be under the direct control and
 supervision of the Department of Health (DOH).

[SEC. 2. Any future increase in bed capacity, healthcare facilities, service capability, and
 human resource complement shall be based on the hospital development plan that shall be
 prepared by the DOH and aligned with Republic Act No. 11223, otherwise known as the
 Universal Health Care Act.]

SEC. 2. TO ENSURE THE PROVISION OF INTEGRATED AND EFFICIENT
HEALTH CARE SERVICES IN THE PROVINCE OF QUEZON, THE LUCENA CITY
HOSPITAL SHALL CONSULT AND COORDINATE WITH THE PROVINCIAL
GOVERNMENT OF QUEZON IN THE FORMULATION AND IMPLEMENTATION
OF ITS HOSPITAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

SEC. 3. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the Department's program
 the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General
 Appropriations Act.

21 SEC. 4. If any provision or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the remaining 22 parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 5. All laws, executive orders, issuances, and rules and regulations inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation. 2 3
