RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE ASIA'S FIRST GRANDMASTER AND CHESS HALL-OF-FAMER, EUGENE TORRE, FOR RULING THE 2023 GUAM INTERNATIONAL OPEN CHESS TOURNAMENT HELD AT THE DUSIT BEACH RESORT IN TUMO, GUAM

WHEREAS, the Senate has, on several occasions, given recognition and commendation to outstanding Filipinos for their contribution in showcasing our nation's promising potential in the various fields and disciplines of sports and in bringing pride and honor to the country by winning in international competitions;
