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

AN ACT

LOWERING THE OPTIONAL RETIREMENT AGE OF GOVERNMENT WORKERS FROM SIXTY (60) YEARS TO FIFTY-SIX (56) YEARS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 13-A OF REPUBLIC ACT 8291, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE GOVERNMENT SERVICE INSURANCE SYSTEM ACT OF 1997"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Section 13-A of Republic Act No. 8291, otherwise known as "The 1 Government Service Insurance System Act of 1997" is hereby amended to read as 2 follows: 3 "SEC. 13-A. Conditions for Entitlement. - A member who 4 retires from the service shall be entitled to the retirement benefits 5 enumerated in paragraph (a) of Section 13 hereof: Provided, That 6 **SUCH MEMBER:** 7 (1) [he] has rendered at least fifteen (15) years of service; 8 (2) [he] is at least [sixty (60)] FIFTY-SIX (56) years of age 9 at the time of retirement; and 10 (3) [he] is not receiving a monthly pension benefit from 11 permanent total disability." 12

- Sec. 2. *Repealing Clause.* All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations, or other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- Sec. 3. *Effectivity.* This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
