A RESOLUTION

COMMENDING ALL FILIPINO ATHLETES AND COACHING STAFF FOR THEIR EXEMPLARY PERFORMANCE IN THE 23^{RD} SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES

Whereas, the Philippines is the 23rd Southeast Asian (SEA) Games overall champion;

Whereas, this is the first time that the Philippines will receive this distinction since its inclusion in the Southeast Asian Games Federation in 1977;

Whereas, the 892 Filipino delegates garnered a total of 113 gold medals, 81 silver medals, and 93 bronze medals, as of the latest tally by the Philippine Olympic Committee, very much ahead of overall second-placer Thailand;

Whereas, several Filipino athletes were able to break existing SEA Games records;

Whereas, despite limited financial resources and inadequate training facilities and equipment, our athletes were able to overcome these obstacles; and through intense training and determination, they exceeded our countrymen's expectations;

Whereas, this achievement has given hope to the Filipino people that the Philippines will perform well in future regional and international sporting events;

Whereas, the athletes' exemplary performance has given pride and honor to our country;

Whereas, for the training, hard work, and sacrifice put into the competition by our athletes and coaching staff, they deserve recognition;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that all Filipino athletes and coaching staff are commended for their laudable performance in the 23rd Southeast Asian Games.
