AN ACT AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10361 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "DOMESTIC WORKERS ACT" OR "BATAS KASAMBAHAY"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Domestic workers or kasambahays have been an integral part of every Filipino household. It is through them that a lot of people are able to live comfortably without sacrificing their careers or family lives. Indeed, the significant contributions of kasambahays extends beyond our households unto helping even the economy, yet they remain to be undervalued and still form part of the marginalized sector of our society.

This bill seeks to facilitate full implementation of the provisions of the Batas Kasambahay Law through a clearer and stricter monitoring system — through the establishment of the Kasambahay Registry and Kasambahay Help Desk and/or Hotline; and a more active information dissemination campaign.

In addition, the bill aims to strengthen the current Batas Kasambahay Law by imposing specific criminal liabilities on abusive employers, in order to deter the continuous incidence of abused kasambahays in our country.

With these proposed changes, it is our aim to provide our kasambahays with greater and more guaranteed protection of their rights, to prevent any cases of abuse against them, and to help improve their quality of life for a better future for them and their family.

It is for these reasons that the immediate passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

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Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. After Section 36 of R.A 10361, insert a new Article VII entitled Registry of Kasambahay to read as follows:

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ARTICLE VII

REGISTRY OF KASAMBAHAY

SECTION. 37. REGISTRY OF KASAMBAHAY. – EVERY
BARANGAY, MUNICIPALITY, AND CITY SHALL MAINTAIN A
REGISTRY OF KASAMBAHAYS AS PART OF THEIR OFFICIAL
RECORDS. THE REGISTRY SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING
INFORMATION:

a. NAME OF KASAMBAHAY;

- b. AGE;
- 13 c. RESIDENCE AND/OR DOMICILE
- 14 **d. CONTACT NUMBER;**
- e. NAME, CONTACT NUMBER, AND ADDRESS OF CURRENT

 EMPLOYER;
 - f. DATE OF EMPLOYMENT AS INDICATED IN THE EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT.

EMPLOYERS SHALL SUBMIT A COPY OF THE EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT TO THEIR RESPECTIVE BARANGAYS WITHIN A PERIOD OF SIX (6) MONTHS FROM THE EMPLOYMENT DATE OF THE KASAMBAHAY.

EVERY BARANGAY SHALL MAINTAIN A REGISTRY OF KASAMBAHAY TO BE UPDATED EVERY 6 MONTHS. A COPY OF THE UPDATED LIST OF KASAMBAHAYS SHALL BE SUBMITTED, BY ALL BARANGAY CHAIRMAN, TO THE MUNICIPAL OR CITY OFFICE ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 18 OF EACH YEAR. EVERY MUNICIPALITY OR CITY SHALL MAINTAIN A CONSOLIDATED LIST OF ALL KASAMBAHAYS, BASED FROM THE SUBMISSION OF ALL BARANGAYS, AND SHALL TRANSMIT COPIES OF THE UPDATED LIST TO THE DOLE, DSWD, CHR, AND THE PNP.

A COPY OF THIS ACT AS AMENDED SHALL BE POSTED IN ALL PUBLIC PLACES, IE: BARANGAY HALL, PUBLIC MARKET, PUBLIC PLAZA OR PARK, PARISH, HEALTH CENTERS, AMONG OTHERS; AND IN THE OFFICIAL SOCIAL MEDIA ACCOUNTS OF EACH BARANGAY, MUNICIPALITY, AND CITY.

SECTION 38. KASAMBAHAY HELP DESK AND/OR HOTLINE. — A KASAMBAHAY HELP DESK AND/OR HOTLINE SHALL ALSO BE MAINTAINED IN EVERY BARANGAY, MUNICIPAL, OR CITY HALL THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY. IN EVERY BARANGAY, THE KASAMBAHAY HELP DESK AND/OR HOTLINE SHALL BE AVAILABLE 24/7, MANNED WITH A TRAINED PERSONNEL OR OFFICER EACH TOUR OF DUTY.

Section 3. Article VII of RA No. 10361 shall now become Article VIII and the sections thereof renumbered accordingly.

1	Section 4. Article VIII of RA No. 10361 shall now become as Article IX and the

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18	Section. [39] 41 . "Araw Ng Mga Kasambahay". – [The date upon which

20	OF JANUARY shall be designated as the "Araw ng mga Kasambahay".
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22	Section 5. Article IX of RA No. 10361 shall now become Article X.
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24	Section 6. Section 40 of RA 10361 shall now become Section 41 and the
25	subsequent sections shall be renumbered accordingly. Section 41 as amended will
26	now read as follows:

31	SEC. [40] 41. Penalties. – a. Any violation of the provision of this Act

[Ten-Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00)] ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000.00) but not more than [Forty Thousand Pesos (P40,000.00)] TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P250,000.00) without prejudice to the filing of appropriate civil or criminal action.

b. ANY EMPLOYER OR ANY RELATIVE OR MEMBER OF THE HOUSEHOLD OF THE SAID EMPLOYER WHO SHALL DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, SUBJECT A DOMESTIC WORKER OR "KASAMBAHAY" TO ANY FORM OF ABUSE, PHYSICAL VIOLENCE OR HARASSMENT SHALL SUFFER THE FOLLOWING:

1. IF NO INJURY WAS CAUSED, OR ONLY MINOR INJURIES WERE CAUSED, THE PENALTY OF IMPRISONMENT RANGING FROM SIX (6) MONTHS AND ONE (1) DAY TO FOUR (4) YEARS AND TWO (2) MONTHS AND A FINE NOT LESS THAN TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P250,000.00) BUT NOT MORE THAN FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P500,000.00);

2. IF BY REASON OR ON THE OCCASION OF SUCH ABUSE, PHYSICAL VIOLENCE OR HARASSMENT INFLICTED, THE KASAMBAHAY SHALL BECOME DEFORMED, OR SHALL HAVE LOST ANY BODY PART, OR HAVE LOST THE USE THEREOF, THE EMPLOYER OR MEMBER OF THE HOUSEHOLD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAME SHALL SUFFER THE PENALTY OF IMPRISONMENT RANGING FROM FOUR (4) YEARS, TWO (2) MONTHS AND ONE (1) DAY TO EIGHT (8) YEARS AND A FINE NOT LESS THAN ONE MILLION PESOS (P1,000,000.00).

3. IF BY REASON OR ON THE OCCASION OF SAID ABUSE, PHYSICAL VIOLENCE OR HARASSMENT INFLICTED, THE KASAMBAHAY SHALL BECOME INSANE, IMBECILE,

1	IMPOTENT, OR BLIND, THE EMPLOYER OR MEMBER OF
2	THE HOUSEHOLD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAME SHALL
3	SUFFER THE PENALTY OF IMPRISONMENT FOR EIGHT (8)
4	YEARS AND ONE (1) DAY TO TWELVE (12) YEARS AND A
5	FINE NOT LESS THAN TWO MILLION PESOS
6	(P2,000,000.00) BUT NOT MORE THAN FOUR MILLION
7	PESOS (P4,000,000).
8	4. IF BY REASON OR ON THE OCCASION OF THE SAID
9	ABUSE, PHYSICAL VIOLENCE OR HARASSMENT
10	INFLICTED, THE KASAMBAHAY DIED, THE PENALTY OF
11	IMPRISONMENT OF TWELVE (12) YEARS AND ONE (1)
12	DAY TO TWENTY (20) YEARS AND A FINE NOT LOWER
13	THAN P5,000,000 SHALL BE IMPOSED.

15	C. ANY NATIONAL OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL OR
16	EMPLOYEE WHO SHALL FAIL TO TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION, ON
17	ANY REPORTED OR SUSPECTED CASE OF ABUSE ON KASAMBAHAY,
18	SHALL BE HELD ADMINISTRATIVELY LIABLE AND SHALL SUFFER A
19	FINE OF NOT LESS THAN ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS
20	(P100,000.00) BUT NOT MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED FIFTY
21	THOUSAND PESOS (P250,000.00). IN ADDITION, THE PENALTY OF

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26	Section 7. Final Provisions. – Article X of RA No. 10361 shall now become
27	Article XI and the sections thereunder shall be renumbered accordingly.
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29	Section 8. Section 44 shall now become Section 45 and amended to read as
30	follows:
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ARTICLE [X] XI

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SEC. 44. Repealing Clause. – [All articles or provisions of Chapter III (Employment of Househelpers) of Presidential Decree No. 442, as amended and renumbered by Republic Act No. 10151 are hereby expressly repealed. All laws, decrees, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified—accordingly.] ALL OTHER LAWS, ACTS, PRESIDENTIAL DECREES, EXECUTIVE ORDERS, PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATIONS, ISSUANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS, OR PARTS THEREOF WHICH ARE NOT CONTRARY TO OR INCONSISTENT WITH ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
