AN ACT

RENAMING MOTOR VEHICLE USER'S CHARGE INTO MOTOR VEHICLE ROAD USER'S TAX AND INCREASING THE RATES FOR PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE MODERNIZATION AND ROAD SAFETY PROGRAMS, AMENDING FOR THIS PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8794, ENTITLED "AN ACT IMPOSING A MOTOR VEHICLE USER'S CHARGE ON OWNERS OF ALL TYPES OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES," AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11239

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Republic Act No. 8794, as amended by Republic Act No. 11239,
- 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 2. Coverage. - [In lieu of the registration fee under Section 8 of Republic Act No. 4136, as amended by Batas Pambansa Bilang 74, and the Private Motor Vehicle Tax under Executive Order No. 43, series of 1986, there is hereby]
THE MOTOR VEHICLE ROAD USER'S TAX SHALL BE imposed on every motor vehicle, whether for hire or for private use, including government motor vehicles as [more fully] provided in Section 3 hereof [a Motor Vehicle User's Charge (MVUC)], which shall be collected from and paid by the owner of the motor vehicle."

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SEC. 2. Section 3 of Republic Act No. 8794, as amended by Republic Act No. 11239, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 3. [Rates of the Motor Vehicle User's Charge. -] RATES OF 13 14 MOTOR VEHICLE ROAD USER'S TAX. - [(a) For private passenger cars registered as of the date of the effectivity of this Act, the MVUC to be paid shall 15 16 be the private motor vehicle tax under Executive Order No. 43, series of 1986, plus twenty-five percent (25%) for the first year, fifty percent (50%) for the second 17 18 year, seventy-five percent (75%) for the third year, and one hundred percent (100%) for the fourth year and thereafter: Provided, however, That private 19 passenger cars to be registered for the first time after the effectivity of this Act, 20 21 shall be subject to the MVUC rates prescribed in Section 3(b) hereof.]

["(b) Except as provided under Section 3(a) hereof, for each motor vehicle 23 24 under each of the categories as herein provided, the MVUC shall be collected from 25 and paid by the vehicle owner, at the following base rates plus twenty-five percent (25%) in the first year from the effectivity of this Act; the said base rates plus fifty 26 27 percent (50%) in the second year from the effectivity of this Act; the said base 28 rates plus seventy-five percent (75%) in the third year from the effectivity of this 29 Act; and the said base rates plus one hundred percent (100%) in the fourth year 30 from the effectivity of this Act and thereafter: Provided, That the MVUC for sports utility vehicles shall be fifteen percent (15%) higher than the MVUC herein 31

"PROVIDED, THAT A PUBLIC UTILITY BUS OR JEEPNEY
SHALL ENJOY 50% DISCOUNT FROM THE ABOVE TAX RATES: *PROVIDED*, *HOWEVER*, THAT THE RATES OF MOTOR VEHICLE
ROAD USER'S TAX SHALL BE INCREASED BY FIVE PERCENT (5%)
EVERY YEAR EFFECTIVE ON JANUARY 1, 2027 THROUGH
REVENUE REGULATIONS ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY OF
FINANCE.

"AS USED IN THIS SECTION -

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"(A) MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL MEAN ANY VEHICLE 3 **PROPELLED BY ANY POWER OTHER THAN MUSCULAR POWER** 4 USING THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS BUT EXCEPTING AIRCRAFT, 5 MOTOR BOATS, ROAD ROLLERS, TROLLEY CARS, STREET 6 SPRINKLERS, LAWN MOWERS, **BULLDOZERS**, SWEEPERS, 7 GRADERS, FORK LIFTS, AMPHIBIAN TRUCKS, CRANES NOT 8 USED IN PUBLIC HIGHWAYS, VEHICLES WHICH RUN ONLY ON 9 RAILS OR TRACKS. AND TRACTORS, TRAILERS, AND 10 TRACTION ENGINES OF ALL KINDS USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR 11 **AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES.** 12

"TRAILERS HAVING ANY NUMBER OF WHEELS, WHEN PROPELLED OR INTENDED TO BE PROPELLED BY ATTACHMENT TO A MOTOR VEHICLE SHALL BE CLASSIFIED AS SEPARATE MOTOR VEHICLE WITH NO POWER RATING.

"(B) GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT SHALL MEAN THE 19 **MEASURED WEIGHT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE AS SPECIFIED BY THE** 20 MANUFACTURER PLUS THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE CARRYING 21 CAPACITY IN MERCHANDISE, FREIGHT, OR PASSENGER AS 22 DETERMINED BY THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE LAND 23 **TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO).**" 24

- SEC. 3. Section 4 of Republic Act No. 8794, as amended by Republic Act No. 11239, is
 hereby amended to read as follows:
- "SEC. 4. [Government Motor Vehicles] PAYMENT OF MOTOR
 VEHICLE ROAD USER'S TAX. The manner of payment of the [user's
 charge] MOTOR VEHICLE ROAD USER'S TAX on government motor
 vehicles shall be in accordance with the procedure that shall be promulgated by
 the Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM)[.]:

"(A) *MANNER OF PAYMENT* – THE MOTOR VEHICLE ROAD USER'S TAX SHALL BE PAID TO THE LTO ANNUALLY UPON REGISTRATION, CONFORMABLY WITH THE REGULATIONS ISSUED JOINTLY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE (DOF) AND THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOTr).

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(B) *MANNER OF COLLECTION OF REVENUES* – THE MOTOR VEHICLE ROAD USER'S TAX SHALL BE COLLECTED BY THE LTO AS PART OF THE ANNUAL VEHICLE REGISTRATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RATES SET FORTH IN SECTION 3 HEREOF. THE DATES OF ANNUAL REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES SHALL BE BASED ON THE REGISTRATION SCHEME PROVIDED BY THE LTO.

"(C) EFFECT OF FAILURE TO PAY MOTOR VEHICLE ROAD USER'S TAX – ANY REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES NOT RENEWED ON OR BEFORE THE DATE FIXED BY THE LTO SHALL BE CONSIDERED DELINQUENT AND INVALID."

SEC. 4. Section 7 of Republic Act No. 8794, as amended by Republic Act No. 11239, is
hereby further amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 7. Disposition of Monies Collected. - All monies collected under 23 24 this Act shall be remitted to the National Treasury under a special account in the General Fund [to be earmarked solely] for the construction, upgrading, repair and 25 26 rehabilitation of roads, bridges, and road drainage [to be included in the annual 27 General Appropriations **PROVIDED**, THAT THE FUND Act.]: ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL BE DISTINCT AND 28 SEPARATE FROM AND IN ADDITION TO ANY APPROPRIATION 29 AUTHORIZED AND GRANTED ANNUALLY TO THE DEPARTMENT 30 31 OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS: PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE INCREMENTAL REVENUES 32

COLLECTED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL BE ALLOCATED AND USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:

"(1) FORTY-FIVE FOR 4 PERCENT (45%) THE **MODERNIZATION** 5 OF PUBLIC UTILITY **VEHICLES**, PARTICULARLY FOR THE EQUITY 6 SUBSIDY **OF PUBLIC** 7 TRANSPORT OPERATORS CONSOLIDATED AS TRANSPORT 8 **COOPERATIVES FOR THE ACQUISITION OF EURO-4 COMPLIANT** 9 PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES PLYING AUTHORIZED ROUTES AS DETERMINED BY THE DOTr AND THE LAND TRANSPORTATION 10 FRANCHISING AND REGULATORY BOARD (LTFRB): PROVIDED, 11 12 THAT SAID INCREMENTAL REVENUES SHALL BE EARMARKED 13 **UPON APPROVAL OF THIS ACT UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2028 FOR** THE MODERNIZATION OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES: PROVIDED, 14 15 FURTHER, THAT THE EARMARKED FUNDS SHALL REVERT TO THE SPECIAL ACCOUNT IN THE GENERAL FUND EFFECTIVE 16 17 **JANUARY 1, 2029;**

"(2) FIVE PERCENT (5%) FOR GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS TO BE UNDERTAKEN FOR PREVENTION OF DEATHS DUE TO ROAD CRASH, AND ACCIDENT VICTIMS' ASSISTANCE, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING:

"(A) THE IMPROVEMENT OF EXISTING DRIVERS' EDUCATION PROGRAMS, TRAINING ACADEMIES AND DRIVERS' LICENSE EXAMINATIONS BY THE LTO;

"(B) THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ADDITIONAL MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTION CENTERS BY THE LTO;

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31"(C) THE IMPROVEMENT OF ROAD MANAGEMENT32SYSTEMS BY THE DOTr;

1 "**(D)** THE PROVISION OF SUPPLEMENTAL 2 HOSPITALIZATION COVERAGE BY THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH **INSURANCE CORPORATION (PHILHEALTH) FOR VICTIMS OF** 3 4 **ROAD CRASH;**

"(E) THE PROVISION BY THE EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION 6 7 **COMMISSION OF WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION FOR VICTIMS OF ROAD CRASH WHO ARE UNABLE TO BE GAINFULLY EMPLOYED** 8 FOR A CONTINUOUS PERIOD DUE TO DISABILITY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 772, AS AMENDED OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT; AND

14 "(F) THE ESTABLISHMENT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF 15 HEALTH (DOH) OF EMERGENCY CARE FACILITIES IN AREAS THAT HAVE HIGH INCIDENCE OF ROAD ACCIDENTS." 16

SEC. 5. Implementing Rules and Regulations. - The DOTr, in coordination with the DOF, 18 the DOH, the LTFRB and the Department of Public Works and Highways, shall promulgate the 19 20 rules and regulations to implement this Act within thirty (30) days from its effectivity.

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SEC. 6. Separability Clause. - If any provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or 22 23 invalid, other parts or provision hereof not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force 24 and effect.

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SEC. 7. Repealing Clause. - All laws, orders, issuances, circulars, rules and regulation or 26 parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified 27 28 accordingly.

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SEC. 8. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the 30 Official Gazette or in at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation. 31
