Sec. 3. Special Working Holiday. – August 1 of every year is hereby declared
a special working holiday to be known as the "*Araw ng Paglalathala at Pagtatanyag ng Kasarinlan ng Pilipinas.*" This is in recognition and commemoration of the
promulgation of the declaration of Philippine Independence during the Bacoor
Assembly in Bacoor, Cavite, on August 1, 1898, which was subsequently ratified by
