- AN ACT DECLARING THE PROVINCE OF PAMPANGA AS THE "CULINARY CAPITAL OF THE PHILIPPINES"
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
- 1 Section 1. Short Title. The Province of Pampanga
- 2 is hereby declared the "Culinary Capital of the Philippines"
- 3 in recognition of its contribution to the dynamic and rich
- 4 culinary history of the country.
- 5 SEC. 2. Tourism Promotion. The Department of
- 6 Tourism shall feature and promote the Province of
- 7 Pampanga as the "Culinary Capital of the Philippines" in
- 8 all its regional and national promotion programs.

- 1 SEC. 3. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees,
- 2 executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations, or parts
- 3 thereof not consistent with the provisions of this Act are
- 4 hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- 5 SEC. 4. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen
- 6 (15) days after its complete publication in the Official
- 7 Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of general
- 8 circulation.
