NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved, that the Senate of the Philippines lauds the success of Manny Pacquiao in commendably earning the World Boxing Council International Super Featherweight Champion title and bringing honor to his country;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Senate of the Philippines recognizes the inspirational role of Manny Pacquiao's achievements in a nation troubled by political and economic upheavals.
