**HONORING MANNY "PACMAN" PACQUIAO FOR HIS VICTORY IN THE
RECENT BOXING REMATCH IN LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, UNITED STATES OF
AMERICA HELD LAST JANUARY 22, 2006**

WHEREAS, last January 22, 2006, Manny "Pacman" Pacquiao won in the recent Boxing Rematch against Mexican Erik "El Terrible" Morales by Technical Knockout during the 10th round of the rematch, which was held at the Thomas and Mack Center, Las Vegas, Nevada, USA.

WHEREAS, at the age of 27, Manny Pacquiao with his record of 41 wins, 3 losses, 2 draws and 33 knockouts, became the first boxer to stop Morales in his spectacular career while keeping his stature as the peoples' champion;

WHEREAS, his trailblazing achievement has elevated the standing and marketability of talented Filipino boxers and has opened the doors of the elusive international boxing arena for them;
