AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR A COLLEGIATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM TO CHILDREN OF
ALL OFFICERS OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) IN ANY STATE
COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY IN THE COUNTRY TO BE KNOWN
AS "CHILDREN OF POLICE SCHOLARSHIP (COPS) PROGRAM"
AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy – The State as mandated by the Constitution shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all.

To this end, the State shall establish and maintain a system of scholarship grants, student loan programs, subsidies and other incentives which shall be available to deserving students in both public and private schools, specially to the underprivileged.

SECTION 2. Establishment of the Program – There shall be created under the supervision of the Department of Education, a Collegiate Scholarship Program for the Children of all officers of the Philippine National Police Scholarship (COPS) Program".

SECTION 3. Coverage – The benefit of full scholarship assistance is herein granted to children of all officers of the PNP who are in active service.

For the purpose of this Act, full scholarship assistance shall include payment of expenses for tuition, miscellaneous and other fees, as well as cost of books and other materials.

SECTION 4. Entitlement – Only one (1) child from each PNP officer who is at the active service shall be entitled to the scholarship grant herein provided. Once a

1	PNP officer has retired, his/her child shall cease to be a beneficiary of the
2	scholarship grant in the succeeding school year.

4	SECTION 5. The Department of Education shall issue the necessary rules
5	and regulations for the effective implementation of this Scholarship Program.
6	
7	SECTION 6. The amount necessary for the effective implementation of this
8	Act shall be charged to the appropriations for the State Scholarship Program of the
9	Department of Education under the current General Appropriations Act and shall be
10	included in the Annual General Appropriations Act.

12	SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
