The change in the aforesaid nomenclature will certainly define and appropriate role and status of the institution among the members of the league.



AN ACT FURTHER CHANGING THE NOMENCLATURE OF THE NATIONAL LIBRARY INTO THE NATIONAL LIBRARY OF THE PHILIPPINES, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF REPUBLIC ACT NUMBERED THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY THREE, ENTITLED 'AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC LIBRARIES TO THE NATIONAL LIBRARY'

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Republic Act No. 3873 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. The [name] NOMENCLATURE of The National Library is hereby changed to that of [The] the NATIONAL LIBRARY OF THE PHILIPPINES."

SEC. 2. Section 2 of Republic Act No. 3873 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. All references to The National Library in laws, executive orders, rules and regulations shall henceforth be understood to refer to [The] the National Library OF THE PHILIPPINES."

SEC. 3. The Title of Republic Act No. 3873 is further amended to read as follows:

"AN ACT CHANGING THE [NAME] NOMENCLATURE OF THE NATIONAL LIBRARY TO THE NATIONAL LIBRARY OF THE PHILIPPINES"

SEC. 4. All laws, decrees, executive orders, proclamations, rules and regulations, and other issuance, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect upon its publication in at least two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
