EXPLANATORY NOTE

Barangay officials and barangay health workers play a vital role in delivering basic services to the grassroots level. Numerous bills proposing to grant them monetary and non-monetary benefits have been filed, but the government has time and again said it could not afford to do so because it involves appropriation of public funds. Granting them discounts in transportation fares similar to what has been granted to our students nationwide will not entail additional expense on the part of the government and will make our barangay officials and barangay health workers feel that their day-to-day efforts are recognized.

AN ACT GRANTING ALL BARANGAY OFFICIALS AND BARANGAY HEALTH WORKERS A DISCOUNT IN TRANSPORTATION FARES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. All barangay officials, including barangay tanods and members of the Lupong Tagapamayapa, and Barangay Health Workers are hereby granted thirty percent (30%) discount in transportation fares.

Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Communications (DOTC), in coordination with the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations within sixty (60) days upon approval of this Act.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication of the implementing rules in any newspaper of general circulation.
