AN ACT DECLARING JUNE 30 OF EVERY YEAR AS A DAY OF CELEBRATION TO **COMMEMORATE PHILIPPINE FEMINISM**

Be It enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. June 30 of every year is hereby declared a day of celebration to commemorate the founding of the first formal national feminist organization in our country, Association Feminista Filipina, on June 30, 1905. This special day shall also commemorate Philippine Feminism and accord due recognition to the invaluable roles that women have played in nation building, in the national struggle for freedom, and in advancing their status in society through the years.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect on its approval.
