EXPLANATORY NOTE

The proposed measure seeks to protect the general welfare through a more pragmatic penal regulation against gambling, which is certainly inimical to public interest. As it is a declared policy of the State to discourage and prohibit forms of gambling not regulated or sanctioned under existing laws, there is a need to review and amend the same in order to efficiently and effectively carry out the people's crusade against illegal gambling.

Law enforcement against illegal gambling will continue to be ineffective unless the laws provide stiffer penalties for violations thereof, which this bill seeks to provide.*



1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT RATIONALIZING THE LAW AGAINST GAMBLING AND/OR BETTING BY PROVIDING STIFFER PENALTIES, FORFEITURE AND CONFISCATION PROVISIONS AND ESTABLISHING A PRIMA FACIE PRESUMPTION FOR VIOLATIONS THEREFOR, AMENDING FOR THESE PURPOSES PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1602. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

8	SECTION 1. Section 1 of Presidential Decree No. 1602 is hereby amended to read as
9	follows:
10	"Section 1. Penalties The following penalties are hereby imposed:
11	(a) The penalty of PRISION MAYOR IN ITS MEDIUM PERIOD OR A
12	FINE RANGING FROM TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS (P20,000.00) TO
13	FORTY THOUSAND PESOS (P40,000.00), OR BOTH [prision correctional in
14	its medium period or a fine ranging from one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) to six
15	thousand pesos (P6,000.00), and in case of recidivism, the penalty of PRISION
16	MAYOR IN ITS MAXIMUM PERIOD OR A FINE RANGING FROM THIRTY
17	THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS
18	(P60,000.00) OR BOTH [prision mayor in its medium period or a fine ranging
19	from FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P5,000.00) to TEN THOUSAND PESOS
20	(10,000.00), shall be imposed upon:
21	(1) Any person other than those referred to in the succeeding
22	subsections who in any manner, shall directly or indirectly take part in any
23	illegal or unauthorized activities or games of cockfighting, jueteng, jai-
24	alai, or horse racing to include bookie operation and game-fixing,

numbers, bingo, and other forms lotteries, cara y cruz, pompiang and the

like 7-11 and any game using dice, blackjack, lucky nine, poker and its derivatives, monte, baccarat, *cuajo*, *pagnnguinge* and other card games; paik que, high and low, mahjong, domino and other games using plastic tiles and the likes; slot machines, roulette, pinball, and other mechanical contraptions and devices; dog racing, boat racing, car racing and other forms of individual or team contest to include game fixing, point shaving and other machinations; banking or percentages game or scheme, whether upon chance or skill, wherein wagers consisting of money, articles of value or representative of value are at stake or made.

- (2) Any person shall knowingly permit any form of gambling referred to in the preceding subparagraph to be carried on in an inhabited or uninhabited place or in any building, vessel, or other means of transportation owned or controlled by him: *PROVIDED*, that i[I]f the place where gambling is carried on has a reputation of a gambling place or that prohibited gambling is frequently carried on therein, or the place is a public or government building or barangay hall, the malefactor shall be punished by PRISION MAYOR IN ITS MAXIMUM PERIOD OR A FINE RANGING FROM THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P50,000.00, OR BOTH [*prision correccional* in its maximum period and a fine of SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (P60,000.00).
- (3) Any person who permits or allows his name to be used for illegal gambling or who uses or permits himself to be used as a dummy in connection with illegal gambling.
- (b) The penalty of PRISION MAYOR IN ITS MAXIMUM PERIOD OR FINE RANGING FROM THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (P60,000.00), OR BOTH; *PROVIDED*, THAT THE PENALTY OF *RECLUSION TEMPORAL* AND A FINE RANGING FROM FORTY THOUSAND PESOS (P40,000.00) TO SIXTY THOUSAND

PESOS (P60,000.00) SHALL BE IMPOSED UPON A MAINTAINER OR CONDUCTOR WHO OPERATES THREE OR MORE GAMBLING OR BETTING JOINTS, DENS, OR HOUSES OR WHEN THE GAMBLING OR BETTING OPERATION IS OF A LARGE SCALE, SUCH AS WHEN IT COVERS A CITY, MUNICIPALITY, OR BARANGAY;

THE PROPERTY DERIVED BY THE MAINTAINER OR CONDUCTOR, WHO OPERATES THREE OR MORE GAMBLING OR BETTING JOINTS, DENS OR HOUSES, OR WHO OPERATES ON A LARGE SCALE, FROM ILLEGAL GAMBLING OR BETTING SHALL BE FORFEITED AND/OR CONFISCATED IN FAVOR OF THE GOVERNMENT. THE BURDEN OF PROVING THE COMMISSION OF CRIMES COVERED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION. ONCE THE PROSECUTION PROVES THAT THE PROPERTIES OWNED, HELD OR ACCUMULATED BY THE ACCUSED, IN HIS OWN NAME OR IN THOSE OF OTHER PERSONS, IS MANIFESTLY OUT OF PROPORTION TO HIS LAWFUL INCOME, IT SHALL DEVOLVE UPON THE ACCUSED TO SHOW THAT SUCH PROPERTIES WERE ACQUIRED BY LAWFUL MEANS; PROVIDED, THAT ANY PROPERTY WHICHHE DID NOT PROVE AS AMONG THOSE HE ACQUIRED BY LEGAL MEANS SHALL BE PRESUMED TO HAVE BEEN ACQUIRED ILLEGALLY;

UPON THE FILIFNG OF THE CRIMNAL CASE, THE COURT SHALL SCHEDULE A HEARING FOR THE DETERMINATION OF THE PROPERTIES MENTIONED HEREIN WHICH MAY BE CONFISCATED AND FORFEITED. DURING THE PENDENCY OF THE CASE, NO PROPERTY, OR INCOME DERIVED THEREFROM, WHICH MAY BE CONFISCATED AND FORFEITED, MAY BE DISPOSED, ALIENATED, OR TRANSFERRED AND THE SAME SHALL BE IN CUSTODIA LEGIS AND NO BOND BE ADMITTED FOR THE RELEASE OF THE SAME.

THE PROCEEDS OF ANY SALE OR DISPOSITION OF ANY PROPERTY OR MONEY CONFISCATED OR FORFEITED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE USED TO PAY ALL PROPER EXPENSES OF SEIZURE, CUSTODY AND MAINTENANCE OF PROPERTY PENDING ITS DISPOSITION, ADVERTISING, PUBLICATION, AND COURT COSTS:

- (c) The penalty of *PRISION MAYOR* IN ITS MAXIMUM PERIOD OR A FINE RANGING FROM FORTY THOUSAND PESOS (P40,000.00) TO SIXTY THOUSAND PESOS (P60,000.00), OR BOTH, [prision mayor in its medium period with temporary absolute disqualification or fine of SIX THOUSAND PESOS] shall be imposed if the maintainer, conductor or banker of said gambling schemes is a government official, or where such government official is the player, promoter, referee, umpire, judge, or coach in case of game fixing, point shaving and machination;
- (d) The penalty of prision correccional in its medium period or a fine ranging from FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P5,000.00) TO TEN THOUSAND PESOS (P10,000.00), OR BOTH [four hundred pesos (P400.00) to TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) shall be imposed upon any person who shall knowingly and without lawful purpose in any hour of any day, possess any lottery list, paper, or other matter containing letters, figures, signs or symbols AND OTHER GAMBLING PARAPHERNALIA pertaining to or in any manner used in the same games of jueteng, jai-alai or horse racing bookies, and similar games of lotteries and numbers which have taken place or about to take place: PROVIDED. THAT POSSESSION OF SAID ARTICLES OR PARAPHERNALIA SHALL BE PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE OF THE VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION: PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT SUCH ARTICLES FOUND IN HIS POSSESSION SHALL BE SEIZED AND CONFISCATED IN FAVOR OF THE GOVERNMENT;
- (e) The penalty of PERPETUAL [temporal] absolute disqualification shall be imposed upon any PUBLIC [barangay] official who, with knowledge of the

existence of a gambling house of place in his jurisdiction, fails to abate the same action in connection therewith;

- (f) The penalty of *prision correccional* in its maximum period or a fine ranging from FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P5,000.00) TO TEN THOUSAND PESOS (P10,000.00), OR BOTH, [FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) to TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) shall be imposed upon any security officer, security guard, watchman, private or house detective of hotels, villages, building, enclosure and the like which have the reputation of a gambling place or where gambling activities are being held; and
- (g) ANY PERSON WHO USES DILATORY TACTICS TO HINDER, OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE SUCCESSFUL EXECUTION OF AN OPERATION AGAINST ILLEGAL GAMBLING AND/OR BETTING BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENIES OR BY ANY OTHER AGENCY OF GOVERNMENT OR OTHERWISE EXTENDS PROTECTION TO A MAINTAINER CONDUCTOR, BAKER OR ANY OTHER PERSON OTHERWISE INVOLVED IN ILLEGAL GAMBLING AND/OR BETTING SHALL BE PENALIZED WITH PRISION CORRECIONAL IN ITS MAXIMUM PERIOD OR A FINE RANGING FROM TEN THOUSAND PESOS (P10,000.00) TO TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS (P20,000.00), OR BOTH.

SECTION 2. *Informer's Reward*. – Any person who shall disclose information that will lead to the arrest and final conviction of the malefactor shall be rewarded twenty five percent (25%) of the cash money or articles of value confiscated or forfeited in favor of the government.

SECTION 3. Separability Clause. – If any provision or part hereof, is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the law or the provision otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

- SECTION 4. Repealing Clause. Presidential Decree No. 1602 is hereby amended and
- 2 rule and regulation contrary to, or inconsistent with, the provisions of this Act is hereby repealed,
- 3 modified or amended accordingly.
- 4 SECTION 5. Effectivity Clause. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
- 5 publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
