RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE SENATE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE, THE HONORABLE JUAN M. FLAVIER, FOR PERFORMING HIS DUTIES WITH UTMOST DEDICATION DURING THE SECOND REGULAR SESSION OF THE THIRTEENTH CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES

WHEREAS, the Senate President Pro Tempore, the Honorable Juan M Flavier, competently discharged the responsibilities of his office to the highest degree and demonstrated the qualities of an excellent legislator worthy of the admiration and respect of his colleagues and countrymen;
