## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Biboy Rivera has been representing the country for the past eight years where he has likewise earned international championship titles such as: 2005 SEA Games - Silver Medal, 2004 Hong Kong Open - Masters Champion, 2002 Asian Championship, singles and masters events gold medalists in the Asian Youth Championship;

WHEREAS, Biboy Rivera, has once again proven to the world that Filipino bowlers are indeed world-class champions following the feat of four-time World Cup champions Paeng Nepomuceno and Bong Coo, among others, making all Filipinos proud once again;
