AN ACT DECLARING THE TWELFTH DAY OF OCTOBER OF EVERY YEAR AS A NONWORKING SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF GETAFE, PROVINCE OF BOHOL TO BE KNOWN AS "THE GETAFE FOUNDATION DAY" AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Municipality of Getafe was created as a town on
- October 12, 1875 by virtue of a Royal Decree from an independent parish and
- 3 municipality separating it from its mother town, Inabanga in the Province of
- 4 Bohol.
- 5 SEC. 2. October 12 of every year is hereby declared as a nonworking
- 6 special public holiday in the Municipality of Getafe to commemorate its
- 7 founding anniversary.
- 8 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
