"AN ACT

EXTENDING THE PRESCRIPTIVE PERIOD FOR RECTIFICATION OF SIMULATED BIRTHS AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8552, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "DOMESTIC ADOPTION ACT OF 1998"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of Republic Act No. 8552 is hereby amended to read as
- 2 follows:

3 "SEC. 22. Rectification of Simulated Births. - A person who has simulated birth of a child shall not be punished for such act: Provided, That the simulation 4 was made for the best of the child and that he/she is consistently considered and 5 treated by that person as his/her own son/daughter; Provided, further, That the 6 application for the correction of the birth registration and petition for adoption 7 shall be filed within fifteen (15) years from the effectivity of this Act and 8 9 completed thereafter: Provided, finally, That such person complies with the procedures as specified in Article IV of this Act and other requirements as 10 determined by the Department.". 11

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication
in any two (2) newspapers of general circulation or in the Official Gazette.
