AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO
MR. JOSE R. RODRIGUEZ

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. Jose R. Rodriguez is hereby granted Philippine citizenship
2 with all the rights, privileges and prerogatives appurtenant thereto.

3 Upon the taking and registration of the oath of allegiance to the
4 Republic of the Philippines, Jose R. Rodriguez shall enter upon the full
5 enjoyment of Philippine citizenship.

6 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
