AN ACT AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9280, OTHERWISE KNOWN
AS THE CUSTOMS BROKERS ACT OF 2004, AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 29 of Republic Act No. 9280 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

3 “SEC. 29. [*Prohibition Against Corporate Practice*]

4 *ADMISSION TO PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE.* – The practice of
5 customs broker is a professional service, admission to which
6 shall be determined upon the basis of individual and personal
7 qualifications. [No firm, company, or association may be

1 registered or licensed as such for the practice of customs broker
2 profession.]”

3 SEC. 2. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, presidential decrees, executive
4 orders, memorandum orders, and other administrative orders, rules and
5 regulations or parts thereof contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of
6 this Act are hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

7 SEC. 3. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
8 its publication in at least two national newspapers of general circulation.
