EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to upgrade the retirement benefits now found in various retirement laws for Members of the Constitutional Commissions, and the Ombudsman, by adding survivorship benefits for the surviving legitimate spouse of the said retirees. Said benefit will be equivalent to the monthly pension of the deceased retiree's lifetime pension.

Survivorship pension originally was an integral part of the retirement system for the Armed Forces of the Philippines. But this feature has been included in the revised general retirement system for civilian personnel administered by the GSIS by Presidential Decree No. 1146 since 1977.

The enactment of this bill would be in consonance with the 1987 Constitution provision on the upgrading of retirement benefits (Article XVI, Section 8). It is also in keeping with the public purpose or rationale of the legislative grant of old age retirement pensions to qualified civil servants – *To entice capable men/women of proven probity, integrity and independence to enter and remain in the government service, especially in highly sensitive offices, discharging their duties faithfully and efficiently.* Liberal retirement benefits would assure them a life of relative security after rendering almost a lifetime of public service, when they have lost their vigor or are already old or incapacitated by illness or other disability.


In view thereof, the early passage of this bill is earnestly recommended.

AN ACT
PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF SURVIVORSHIP BENEFITS TO
THE SURVIVING LEGITIMATE SPOUSE OF A DECEASED RETIRED
MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION ON AUDIT, CIVIL SERVICE
COMMISSION, COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS, AND THE
OMBUDSMAN AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled.

SECTION 1. In case of death of a retired Chairman or Commissioner of the Commission on Audit, the Commission on Elections, the Civil Service Commission, and the Ombudsman, the surviving legitimate spouse of said deceased retiree shall be entitled to receive on a monthly basis all the retirement benefits that the said deceased retiree was receiving at the time of his/her demise under the provisions of applicable retirement laws then in force. The said surviving legitimate spouse shall continue to receive such retirement benefits during his/her lifetime or until he/she remarries.

SEC. 2. Funds for the initial implementation of this Act shall be taken out of the current appropriations for the retirement benefits of the Chairman and Commissioners of the Constitutional Commissions as well as the Ombudsman and/or savings of said Constitutional Commissions and the Ombudsman. Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary for the continued implementation hereof shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect after thirty (30) days following the completion of its publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
