#### Mr. President :

The Committee on Justice and Human Rights and the Committee on Environment and

Natural Resources, to which was referred House Bill No. 4993 introduced by Representatives Del Mar, Banaag, Gullas and Durano, entitled:

#### "AN ACT

#### CONFIRMING AND DECLARING, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS, THE VALIDITY OF EXISTING TRANSFER CERTIFICATES OF TITLE AND RECONSTITUTED CERTIFICATES OF TITLE COVERING THE BANILAD FRIAR LANDS ESTATE, SITUATED IN THE FIRST DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF CEBU"

has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the following amendments:

- On page 2 line 8, after the word "thereof" add a proviso "; EXCEPT 1. WHEN, IN A GIVEN CASE INVOLVING A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OR A RECONSTITUTED CERTIFICATE OF TITLE, THERE IS CLEAR EVIDENCE THAT SUCH CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OR RECONSTITUTED CERTIFICATE OF TITLE WAS OBTAINED THROUGH FRAUD, IN WHICH CASE THE SOLICITOR GENERAL DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE DULY SHALL OR HIS INSTITUTE THE NECESSARY JUDICIAL PROCEEDING ΤO CANCEL THE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OR RECONSTITUTED CERTIFICATE OF TITLE, AS THE CASE MAY BE, OBTAINED THROUGH SUCH FRAUD.";
- 2. On page 2, lines 9 to 11, delete Section 2; and
- 3. Renumber the sections accordingly.

 are hereby confirmed and declared as valid titles and the registered owners
 recognized as absolute owners thereof.

5 This confirmation and declaration of validity shall in all respects be 6 entitled to like effect and credit as a decree of registration, binding the land and 7 quieting the title thereto and shall be conclusive upon and against all persons, 8 including the national government and all branches thereof.

9 SEC. 2. This Act shall not apply to Transfer Certificates of Title or
10 Reconstituted Certificates of Title declared by final judgment by the courts to
11 have been obtained or issued through fraud or misrepresentation.

SEC. 3. All laws, decrees, proclamations or issuances contrary to or
inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or
modified accordingly.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
in the Official Gazette or in at least two national newspapers of general
circulation.

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
