#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

Cervical cancer is the second most common cancer in women in the country, next to breast cancer. According to the 2005 Philippine Cancer Facts and Estimates, 7, 277 new cases and 3,807 deaths due to cervical cancer were estimated to have occurred. This means that there were approximately ten (10) Filipino women dying each day due to cervical cancer. This is mainly due to late detection and lack of awareness of the disease among Filipino women. <sup>1</sup> As with all cancers in developing countries, cervical cancer is usually diagnosed at an advanced stage. This is in part because of the paucity of effective screening programs.<sup>2</sup>

It is in this light that this bill seeks to create a breast and cervical cancer diagnostic and treatment fund which shall provide financial assistance for the medical care of indigent patients. The bill provides for the composition and administration of the fund, the covered services, eligibility of patients, and the dispersement of funds. It is hoped that this measure would alleviate the struggle of women and their families who have to cope with the life threatening disease. Moreover, as a proactive measure, it seeks to encourage women to undergo screening to protect them from the same.

In view of the foregoing, immediate approval of this measure is earnestly sought.

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#### AN ACT

### PROVIDING FOR A NATIONAL CERVICAL CANCER DIAGNOSTIC AND **TREATMENT FUND**

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled.

SECTION 1. Short Title. - This Act shall be known as the "National Cervical Cancer 1 Diagnostic and Treatment Fund Program." 2

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4 SEC. 2. Declaration of Policy. - It is the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them. 5

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SEC. 3. Definition of Terms. - As used in this article: 7

- 1. "Fund" means the breast and cervical cancer diagnostic and treatment fund. 8
- 2. "Qualified applicant" means a female who meets the financial and medical eligibility 9 10 guidelines of this Act pursuant to Article 5 hereof.
- 3. "Provider" means a physician, hospital or medical provider currently licensed under 11 12 the state.
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SEC. 4. Establishment of Cervical Cancer Diagnostic and Treatment Fund. - There is 14 hereby established a cervical cancer diagnostic and treatment fund which shall provide financial 15 16 assistance for the medical care of indigent patients for diagnostic and treatment services for 17 breast and cervical cancer.

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1 The fund shall be comprised of money appropriated to the fund by the Legislature, 2 allocated to the fund by the national government and all other sums designated for deposit in the 3 fund from any source, public or private.

The fund shall be administered by the University of the Philippines – Department of
Health Cervical Cancer Screening Research Group (hereinafter referred to as the UP-DOH
CCSRG).

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8 SEC. 5. *Covered Services.* – The Secretary of the DOH shall appoint a committee of four 9 physicians from the UP-DOH CCSRG to promulgate the rules and regulations for the 10 administration of the fund.

11 The committee shall include one physician whose specialty is gynecological oncology, 12 one physician whose specialty is surgery, one physician whose specialty is radiology and one 13 physician whose specialty is pathology.

Responsibilities of the committee include, but are not limited to, the following:

 *Establishing a list of covered services approved for payment through the fund.* –
 Covered services include diagnostic and treatment services for cervical cancer or a
 condition suggestive of cancer. An ancillary diagnostic study may be authorized only
 when it is determined by the UP-DOH CCSRG to be directly related to the confirmation
 of a diagnosis of cancer or is necessary for treatment planning;

20 2. Setting a limitation on days of service covered by the fund. – The PGH shall authorize
21 the number of days for reimbursement based on the medical condition of the patient and
22 the procedure to be performed; and

23 3. Reviewing requests and providing authorization for payment of diagnostic or
24 treatment services covered by the fund.

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SEC. 6. Patient Eligibility. – To be eligible for assistance in payment of services under
 the fund, the following conditions shall be met:

281.The patient is not eligible for nor covered by medical insurance other than the29Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (hereinafter referred to as PhilHealth); and

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1	2. The patient's income must be at or below the National Poverty Threshold or
2	Poverty Line based on the data provided by the National Statistical Coordination Board
3	(NCSB); and
4	3. The patient has a condition clinically indicative of cancer that requires diagnostic
5	services to confirm the preliminary diagnosis and only those services determined to be
6	medically necessary for that diagnostic confirmation may be authorized by the committee
7	for payment from the fund; or
8	4. The patient has received diagnostic confirmation through a positive pathology report
9	and is requesting payment of treatment services by the fund.
10	
11	SEC. 7. Application Process The PGH shall develop authorization request forms and
12	make the forms available to the provider upon request.
13	An application for inpatient diagnostic services shall be accompanied by a written, signed
14	statement from the attending physician which includes the medical basis for required inpatient
15	services and explains why the services may not be performed on an outpatient basis.
16	:
17	SEC. 8. Reimbursement Process The fund is the payor of last resort. Payment for
18	procedures shall be made at the current rate established by PhilHealth.

A claim for authorized services rendered shall be processed in accordance with rulespromulgated by the UP-DOH CCSRG.
