

RESOLUTION

URGING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON GAMES, AMUSEMENTS AND SPORTS TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, INTO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SPORTS FOR ALL PROGRAM AIMED AT CHARTING A COMPREHENSIVE NATIONAL SPORTS DEVELOPMENT AGENDA FOR COMPETITIVE AND WORLD-CLASS FILIPINO ATHLETES

**WHEREAS**, Section 17, Article II of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall give priority to sports to foster patriotism and nationalism;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order Nos. 63 and 64 were enacted for the purpose of assigning responsibilities to various agencies in the field of sports development;

**WHEREAS**, in 2005, the Philippines won the overall championship in the SEA Games while landing the second most number of medals won in 2007, in between landing its best performance in the Asian Games in 40 years;

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Sports Program has come to fore recently for having failed to land a single medal in the recently concluded Beijing Olympic Games;

**WHEREAS**, the Partnership Program for Sports for All, which mobilized financial and in-kind resources only needs a more effective coordination and management so that *there is a smarter prioritization and allocation of resources thus made available, keeping in mind that the sports sectors most likely to win medals in the Olympics should be given top priority*; NOW THEREFORE BE IT

**RESOLVED**, the Senate of the Philippines to urge the Senate Committee on Games, Amusements and Sports to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, into the implementation of the Sports For All program aimed at charting a comprehensive national sports development agenda *for competitive and world-class Filipino athletes*
