
The Committees on Education, Arts and Culture and on Finance to which

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY
BOGAYO, MUNICIPALITY OF KUMALARANG, PROVINCE
OF ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR TO BE KNOWN AS THE BOGAYO
NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS
THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Establishment of a National High School.* – There is
2 hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of Education, a
3 national high school in Barangay Bogayo, Municipality of Kumalarang,
4 Province of Zamboanga del Sur to be known as the Bogayo National High
5 School.

6 SEC. 2. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of the Department of
7 Education shall immediately include in the Department's program the
8 operationalization of the Bogayo National High School, the funding of which
9 shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

10 SEC. 3. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of the Department of
11 Education shall issue such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry
12 out the purpose of this Act.

13 SEC. 4. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
14 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
