

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY
OZAMIZ (GUBA), MUNICIPALITY OF CLARIN, PROVINCE OF
MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL TO BE KNOWN AS CONGRESSMAN
HILARION J. RAMIRO, JR. MEMORIAL NATIONAL HIGH
SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. *Establishment of a National High School.* – There is
2 hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of Education, a
3 national high school in Barangay Ozamiz (Guba), Municipality of Clarin,
4 Province of Misamis Occidental to be known as Congressman Hilarion J.
5 Ramiro, Jr. Memorial National High School.
- 6 SEC. 2. *Appropriations.* – *The Secretary of Education shall*
7 *immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the*
8 *Congressman Hilarion J. Ramiro, Jr. Memorial National High School, the*
9 *funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.*
- 10 SEC. 3. *Implementation.* – *The Secretary of Education shall issue rules*
11 *and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.*
- 12 SEC. 4. *Effectivity.* – *This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after*
13 *its publication in the Official Gazette.*
